INTRODUCTION

This is an Astro-Analysis based on the exact time, date, and place of birth calculated on the details supplied.

It is not intended to predict a budding mega-star or a future world leader - the objective is to provide some insights into the psyche of Charlotte to give everyone concerned a better chance of understanding, and hopefully helping this special child through the difficult growing times that they will face.

The astrological Chart is a little like a jigsaw puzzle without the benefit of a picture to follow. Some pieces are easy to recognize and they fit together beautifully. Another batch might fit well - but seem unrelated to the first "batch". Several straggly bits probably seem to belong to another world altogether, but that is the human psyche. The depths are immeasurable with many, many forms, faces, and dimensions.

Any Astrological chart will have seemingly several contradictions - again - just like human nature and our psychological make-up. But these apparent differences are all shades, shapes, and forms of the full picture. These "contradictions" should be seen as a balancing factor, knocking some of the edges off our sharp corners or, sharpening up the "softness" in the areas defined.

It should also be recognized that all of us have our own very personal lessons to learn in this life and these lessons unfold throughout the span of our entire life on earth. The learning experiences will not be systematic - they will be random episodes and experiences. Some interpretations of this Chart will give a glimpse of these very personal lessons that are an obvious part of this little ones' character. Others may be so private or subtle that the child "learns" all by itself. And then there will be further lessons that will not have emerged or even seem significant yet.

It is hoped that the brief explanations throughout this analysis will help to explain the meanings and terminology of basic Astrology to give as much understanding as possible.

The two most valuable things that we can give to any child are our unconditional love and our time.

Nothing is quite like having a Chart done on a "one-to-one" basis, but this enormous electronic age has opened the way for anyone who is interested to have a closer look at this ancient science and benefit from its wisdom.

Planets in Signs and Houses



Libra Ascendant

The Ascendant is the exact degree in the zodiac, which was rising on the horizon at the time of birth. The term Ascendant and Rising sign are the same. Every 4 minutes the degree of the Ascendant changes. This is why it is so important to know the exact time of birth. This is the starting point of the astrological wheel and defines the signs on each house cusp in an anti-clockwise direction.

The actual houses and their meanings are just as important as the signs on the cusp. The sign of the Ascendant is as important as the Sun sign, and its effects are often more obvious to other people. The Ascendant represents how the personality appears to others. Each sign has its own potential strengths, which should be developed, and weaknesses, which should be minimized through understanding. Charlotte may run into problems if the rising sign is quite different in nature from the Sun sign. There will be conflict between an element of the inner self and the projected image. So, if any recurring social problems do occur, it is necessary to look within. The Ascendant in the chart is very important. It indicates the ways in which we interact with the world around us, the energies we put out, and the energies we receive from others.

Aspects to the Ascendant indicate what kinds of interaction we experience with others, the impressions we make on people, and the areas of our life that most involve other people. Often these aspects tell us about ourselves.

The Ascendant or Rising sign of this chart for Charlotte is in the sign of Libra - the peacemaker, the arbitrator - the diplomatic. These kids are very sociable, gracious, and compatible. Libra the scales leans towards balance and judgement. These types will always see both sides of the story. Their conclusions will always be fair, although these kids do tend to say what "others wants to hear", rather than what they do actually think. These little diplomats hate to offend. They hate to cause ripples. Many political leaders have Libra rising, so do not be fooled - these kids strive to win - but nicely! Friendships and relationships and other people are of great importance, in fact, Charlotte may not like to be alone for any length of time.

Because of a real concern about getting along with people and being accepted, Charlotte will take the trouble to learn how. So, these kids will never be short of friends. In many ways they often get their own way, but instead of using force to persuade people, they use charm. Even in a sticky situation, Charlotte can get out of it by finding the right words, instinctively knowing how to calm ruffled feathers. This child will seldom truly offend anyone, which is just as well. These kids will not enjoy any sort of unpleasantness. It upsets them badly. This agreeable child, though, must learn to be sure not to compromise too much. Charlotte may need to learn to be more forthright, to not be afraid to speak out and oppose on important issues. Many people with Libra rising actually become quite competitive, once they have gotten over the stage of being so accommodating. So, Charlotte can learn to be a bit "tougher".

Even in the area of visual effect, there is repugnance with ugliness. These people will try improving by camouflage or adding their own bit of beauty. In this same spirit, Charlotte will like beautiful clothes or even flashy gear, although some element in the taste usually prevents these kids from dressing too gaudily. Obviously, the choice is to be surrounded by beautiful things. The expensive taste for art, music, and literature can emerge at quite a young age.

The home environment probably seems to run like clockwork to this child with the Libra Ascendant. Certainly, the parents, or at least one parent, will work very hard for what they get. Their practical approach will ensure that the family wants for none of the essentials. The Mother figure is probably very well organized. It is likely that she will have a career or at least lead a very busy life. This little one should want for nothing major, but would probably love a few more frills and luxuries than what they get. In fact, Charlotte may feel hard done by because the parents are not extravagant. But these children should feel loved and cared for. They will break their necks to grow up though, to be able to buy all those luxurious things that they will love so much.

Venus, the Planet of love and possessions and artistic ability is the Ruling Planet of this Chart for Charlotte, which will be an essential part of the personality. Pay special attention to the House in which Venus falls, as this is where the charm of Venus will flourish.



Sun in Pisces

The Sun in the Chart is our personal light. It is our vitality, our creativity, and our basic ego. It is the Sun that provokes and promotes emotional security. The Sun represents our individuality. Within the Sun sign is our reason for being, our sense of pride, and our confidence. This is the basis of the search for the real person within. The sign occupied by the Sun at birth describes the nature of these basic drives and patterns. It describes the desire to be important to the people that matter and the ability to be independent and self-reliant. It will give us an indication of the methods used to develop psychologically.

The House will describe the areas of life that will be important and play a major role in our lives. It is here that we have the tools and the gifts to use as they were intended. But we may have to learn some vital lessons before this happens.

Much more is revealed by the aspects to the Sun. Positive aspects (trines, conjunctions or sextiles) are good indicators of self-reliance, confidence and the ability to stand on one's own two feet. The difficult aspects (squares, oppositions, and inconjunctions) will suggest psychological problems which can have a profound effect on life. However, learning to deal with these difficulties ultimately produces strength and understanding of the self. The rewards of working through these problems are great. The efforts will be productive. Sure, work is needed, but it is worth the effort. However, whenever the planet, Saturn, brushes up against the Sun, it will suppress and depress the energy of the most exuberant Sun sign.

The Sun is the "self", the "life path", the "true" personality behind all the facades and defenses we all put up.

The child will start to grow into the Sun sign during adolescence which can be another reason why these years can be so dramatic and traumatic - this is just another set of growing pains that we all have to endure. The actual Sun sign is often not fully developed until nearer 30 years of age, but the inner spirit will emerge and glimpses will be seen throughout the growing years.

Charlotte has the Sun in Pisces. The Pisces child is sensitive and idealistic. They are "tuned in" to the environment and aware of everything happening around them. They will pick up a bad atmosphere in an instant and literally "feel" any bad vibes or bad feelings. This is the "dreamer" of the Zodiac - creative, imaginative and often a bit mystical with many "friends" around them that only they can see. But some discipline is needed to keep these little dreamers on track. These kids need their space to collect

their thoughts but must be drawn back into the real world if they go too far or for too long.

The Pisces child can be temperamental and emotional. In times of stress, they can close off completely. They are so very sensitive and very easily hurt but do need to be taught that a bit of reality is vital to their emotional well-being. These kids are usually rather shy and should not be forced into being what they are not. But make sure the shyness is not total insecurity and a total lack of confidence. Make these gentle kids feel good within and proud of just who they are. It is too easy for them to try too hard to please and so stifle their own personality. Try to make a big deal out of the natural generosity and kindness and help make Charlotte feel proud. The world needs these sensitive kids.

Charlotte will be kind, and loving but easily influenced by others and very easily led. There can be a difficulty being able to say, "No." These kids are often as fond of animals as they are of the human race. They just love to "care" and to "take care of", but these little people need lots of love and encouragement back as well. They may need to learn to accept the love and warmth that they are so fond of giving. The true Piscean character can slip into the role of the self-imposed martyr which would be a great waste of the sensitivity that is here.

These kids can be very artistic and creative with such a powerful imagination. It would be a shame not to nurture these talents which might not always be obvious. The Pisces child will seldom demand anything - even attention.

If there are lots of planets in the sign before or after Pisces (Aries or Aquarius), this little one will be a lot tougher and far more out-going.

Sun in the Fourth House

4th House: This House is about the early home environment, the "Mother" influence, and the family. This is the House where traditions are set and preserved. This is where basic development begins and where lifetime habits are formed. This House is all about nurturing.

Charlotte has the Sun in the Fourth House showing very deep roots to the home and the home environment. There will be a huge need for basic security. The Mother figure will be very important here. All that is learned through early childhood will be the blueprint on how this child runs their adult life.

Sometimes the Sun in this house can show that the early part of life can have some difficulties or hardships. As time goes by, Charlotte will only remember the good times and hold these memories very close. These kids are indelibly marked and conditioned

by their background, family history, and those early years. There will be natural instincts to protect and conserve the traditions as an integral part of the identity. This is a powerful drive.

There can be a few psychological tensions with the Sun in the fourth House. There is a real need for emotional security even within a relatively secure family atmosphere. This child will tend to suffer quite badly from low self-esteem. Charlotte will seem to be a lot more emotional than the rest of the family. These kids may well burst into tears very easily and be rather clingy and moody, But they will often make their feelings felt by throwing a sulk, or storming off, rather than throwing a tantrum. Unfortunately, this often does not clear the air, so the hurts tend to linger for far too long. Charlotte may never forget. It will be far better in the long run if this child is taught to express feelings openly and freely and have the courage to speak up and give an honest opinion - learn how to get that frustration off the chest without it being a major issue, and then learn to forgive and forget.

Although the childhood can be quite strained for Charlotte, this is a good position for the Sun. It often produces increasing prosperity and security in the latter half of life. It also adds vitality and energy during the later years. Quite possibly, interests in land, houses, ecology, natural resources, or conservation can produce good results.



Moon in Leo

The Moon is our instinctive, emotional response. It is the innermost feelings and sensitivities that stem from the subconscious. Our Moon will always be our natural reaction when our defenses are down. The Moon reflects our early conditioning, our habits, and the automatic responses that come from our early environment. Often all of this relates directly to the "Mother" figure. It is perhaps the "child" in all of us. In reading a child's chart, the Moon, in the house, the sign and the aspects, needs to be given special understanding. These are the indications on where Charlotte could need special attention very early, to cope with feelings of insecurity, lack of confidence, or a low self-esteem. Recognizing these needs, and working through them, will help to produce a secure and confident adult.

The Moon often reflects the "Mother figure" in our lives, which is consequently why the Moon figures so strongly in a child's chart. The placement of the Moon often describes

the relationship with the Mother, which is why the "Mother" is mentioned in many areas of the Moon explanations.

The Moon sign is the more noticeable personality trait in the formative years. We tend to "grow into our Sun sign as we develop and become the person we were meant to be. The Moon in the Chart signifies the unconscious attitudes and feelings and whether or not we feel supported and accepted. It is also the accumulated attitude reflected by our own past and the historical past. The Moon will echo values and instincts that are picked up from our early environmental experiences.

This luminary is the most important factor after the influences of the Sun and the Ascendant. It describes how we express our emotions and how well we deal with them. In some cases, the ever-important Sun can put up some defenses against the Moon. When very different, we can struggle to assimilate our emotions and our reason. Like the other planets, the Moon has strong and weak points in any sign, and we should try to develop the strong points. If the Moon is in compatible company, we will express our emotions very easily and we will be sensitive to other people's needs and feelings. With competition, the Moon can mean that there can be difficulty letting our feelings flow. The Moon and the Ascendant can be of an awkward mix, making the projected personality, and how we actually feel inside, quite different. But, this is all a part of the character and we are well able to bind the differences and round off the disposition. The Moon and the emotional problems it produces can sound negative but this is not so. This is a beautiful and fundamental part of our deepest psyche that we must all

accept and use to its fullest advantage.

Charlotte has the Moon in the sign of Leo. These children are very proud, but need to know that their parents, family, friends, in fact, everyone, is proud of them. Leo the Lion is king of the jungle and this child will see itself as self-appointed king or queen of their own regal household. They would prefer that the home was a real-live castle, but even if it is not, this little one will regard the home as just that - their castle. They will love to have friends over to their house to play. They will love to act out scenes, play dressing up, cowboys and Indians - anything where they can use as many of their creative and entertaining talents as they can. This child will want to be in charge and be the "boss", but most of the other kids will be happy to let this happen. There is quite a natural little leader here who knows how to organize group activities.

These kids are flamboyant. They like to be the center of attention and if throwing a glorious tantrum is the only way to be in the spotlight, then these budding Thespians will put on a memorable performance. Most of the time this warm and sunny natured child will be a whole lot of fun. Very popular, very entertaining and very loving, but they do have to learn to play the support role now and again. However, these children do have a lot of pride and take themselves very seriously. They will be mortified if they are made to feel foolish or feel that they have done something badly, or, worst of all, that they have failed. Charlotte will take punishment badly. So when "those" times crop up, apply sound and firm logic rather than keep a bad situation going forever. Let the child see and understand why you are cross. Explain how it could have been handled, and then

let them know that you accept that they are clever enough to have learned. These kids thrive on responsibility and the best way to train them is to give them that chance.

There is one thing that Charlotte will not cope with, and that is being ignored. These kids have very strong feelings. They need a lot of love and attention and can become quite ill if they are left out in the cold for too long. They are easily offended and when all is said and done, will always make their presence felt and their feelings clear. These kids will be simply mystified if communications break down. It hurts them. Another minor danger can be that these children must learn to be themselves and not a projection of what they think is expected of them "in order to be loved". These kids sometimes exaggerate just to appear in a better light, but it will be a rare occasion when this child actually tells lies. Charlotte will be very honest and will expect total honesty in return.

When older, Charlotte will relate very well to younger children and will be the most responsible baby-sitter. These are delightful children. They love to play, love to compete; they are sunny and generous, but they need to learn to lose gracefully too.

Moon in the Ninth House

9th House: This House reflects the influence and the encouragement from teachers, like report cards, recognition of ability - or lack of needed encouragement and advice. This House is about the development of self-esteem. It is about seeking and sharing knowledge. It is about developing skills and setting goals. It is about expanding on what today offers and taking it into the future.

Charlotte has the Moon in the 9th House. This child will be a restless soul forever seeking new experiences, new places, and new people. They will always be looking for fresh stuff to satisfy a natural curiosity. Charlotte will be fascinated with other countries and other cultures and is very likely to travel in adulthood.

These kids are, though, ruled by their emotions. Their thinking is often not particularly objective. They find pure logic too cold and too impersonal, so do need to be taught that there is indeed a need for logic. There is often a deeply spiritual side of the character attached to this placement.

Charlotte will enjoy reading, television sagas, historical dramas, and will get totally engrossed with the fantasy. This little one will be living it - especially the role of the hero or the heroine. These kids have a lively imagination and a gift for communication.

They will be constantly learning, but also tend to be easily influenced by their early years. Charlotte can pick up prejudices and narrow influences, and not put in the time to develop principles that are unique and personal. There will be a need for some gentle guidance to help Charlotte to build a belief system that is a true reflection of the inner

self. Let these beliefs grow, allowing Charlotte to be the well informed, well rounded, intelligent person that this child should truly become.

This is a very receptive and imaginative mind - these kids are forever changing their minds. Charlotte will have a variety of interests and hobbies. These kids will enjoy sharing the knowledge that they have accumulated. In fact, the Moon in the 9th House often signifies a brilliant teacher in adulthood, who not only knows their craft but also has a gift of expression that will inspire the listener.

Mercury in Pisces

The little planet Mercury is the mythical Messenger of the Gods. This planet is never far away from the Sun, often falling in the same sign at the time of birth, so it does tend to add emphasis to our Sun Sign. Even when Mercury is in the sign before or after the Sun, this is always considered a very personal planet.

Through Mercury, we learn all the basics in life. It indicates how we communicate, because it is here where we begin to watch and copy the rest of the family. This is the very beginning of questions and curiosity that fires up and fuels the learning process. From that point, we move on to recognizing the senses, and so our personal tastes and style develops. We learn how to exchange ideas and show how clever we are. We start to question and analyze. We learn to reason and classify what we have absorbed and then stretch for more information.

Mercury is our first experience of moving out into the world beyond the back yard, armed with all that we have learned. Through this planet, our flexibility and dexterity is revealed. This planet covers the intellectual stimuli but it also has a say in how clever we are with our hands and how well balanced we are physically.

Mercury is also associated with the nervous system. This is a busy little planet at the best of times, and responsible for a big part of our intrinsic character. When put under too much pressure, the nervous system buckles. Mercury is indicative of our sense of humor, the body language we exude, and our powers of expression. This is the planet of logic and reason. So, Mercury is indeed a very important planet. It might be tiny, but it is very potent.

Mercury in Pisces will be ruled by powerful feelings. These children will follow their instincts rather than apply logic or reason. If it does not "feel" right, it is simply not right, to them.

Charlotte will be sensitive, intuitive, and have a rich imagination. There is a danger that daydreams and fantasies can be far more exciting and interesting than the issue of taking in all those boring lessons at school. So drifting off can come quite easily. This child can head off to escapism in an instant. It is important that the creativity is drawn out here. All that wonderful imagination should be exploited and used to the fullest. The creative mind is at its strongest in this sign. However, a little bit of practicality has

to be instilled, too. The major problem for these children is getting the confidence to express how they feel clearly and this could take a lot of encouragement and patience. There is a strong tendency to feel very insecure because these little ones are not interested in practical issues, and yet they know they should be.

There should be a natural love of the arts and music, and this is where this timid child might find the confidence to expose their inner thoughts and feelings. Their sense of imagery is quite unique. This very sensitive child is finely tuned into the environment. Charlotte can be quite psychic and will certainly be very intuitive and perceptive. There is a certain naiveté in this gentle child's nature that will always be very appealing.

Mercury in the Fifth House

5th House: Creativity, having fun, playing with, and mixing with others - the essential social interaction. This is the house of developing life skills that involve contact with company. This house is about developing the skills to become popular, confident, and socially accepted. This house also relates strongly with children.

This child with Mercury in the 5th House will enjoy being involved with anything that includes other kids, a challenge, or a bit of drama. Puzzles games, role-playing, dressing up, and later, the challenges of chess or bridge will appeal to them. They will also enjoy complicated computer games that are competitive.

Company of any sort will be a real source of joy and will give a chance to interact with a quite remarkable sense of strategy. Charlotte is bound to have a real need to be the star of the show because these kids do like to be noticed and admired. An attentive audience will really turn Charlotte on.

These children love to read and study. This can be fun for them rather than work BUT it must be through their choice. So, if there happens to be a subject that is considered very important and Charlotte is not interested, try to turn it into fun, and then you will get results. Their communication and written skills are excellent. This could well be an indicator of what Charlotte will do in adult life. Obviously, this area needs to be given plenty of air, space, and encouragement.

This little one will need to learn some discipline. There is a tendency to think that no one else knows very much of anything. Charlotte will feel more comfortable in a learning environment that encourages individual in-put and supports interaction. Any sort of activity that includes expression, like music, dance, or drama, will help to teach discipline and enhance the gifts of this budding performer.

Venus in Pisces

Venus is the planet of love. This tiny planet is responsible for the stirring of the soft and sensual pleasures of nature. Venus opens the doors of appreciation to beauty, harmony, creativity, and of course, love, and affection. Venus arouses and stimulates our senses.

Venus is important because it shows how youngsters interact. It is where children learn to share and give. Venus shows how Charlotte attracts love and attention and also what and who Charlotte is attracted to. This planet will indicate whether the basic nature is warm and affectionate or whether there is some reserve attached.

Venus is also about our creature comforts and possessions - what we need in life to feel good. Venus indicates our creativity and artistic talents and the ability to appreciate beauty. Good, bad, or unusual taste will be seen through Venus.

The house that Venus is in indicates the area in which artistic talent is expressed. This is where the expressions of sensual understanding will be valid and utilized. It can also suggest where Charlotte may need special attention and nourishment, in order to learn how to interact with others.

For future reference, Venus in the signs, houses and aspects will be quite revealing about relationships with the opposite sex and matters of the heart.

With Venus, the planet of love and comfort, in the sensitive sign of Pisces, Charlotte will be a quiet, almost mystical child. These children are drawn to pretty colors and shapes - the clouds, the sky and the Moon will fascinate. The burning fire in the hearth will conjure up all sorts of pictures for Charlotte. The likes of the wind whistling and the rain falling will be music to this deep and sensitive child. There will be a love of glossy books with pretty pictures. Romantic and magical stories that appeal to the imagination will be a real source of pleasure. The world of fantasy can be far more exciting to this child than the real world. If this wonderful imagination is encouraged, it can be very useful in creative, artistic work later, but if this child slips into the world of fantasy to escape, then you should ask why. Coax Charlotte into sharing those beautiful visions. This will be a most unselfish child who will give all that they have materially or spiritually to anyone whom they think is in need. But, Charlotte must also learn how to accept the same in return. Often giving comes easily, but receiving can be a hard one to master.

Charlotte will be deeply sensitive, very compassionate, and very idealistic. There will never be any trouble establishing a relationship, but there will be a strong need to be loved and understood which can often result in disappointment. Equally, later in life, these children can attract a partner who is too dependent. This can often drain the precious personal vitality quite badly. Charlotte will tend to attract the underdog. The fine intuition and the strong compassion that Charlotte has will be easily recognized. The enormous capacity to "give" will be a strong signal. The 'weaker' soul will trust this and be drawn to the inner strength. Unfortunately, when under pressure, Charlotte will tend to suffer in silence, keeping personal problems close to the chest. Charlotte should be taught and encouraged to share problems.

Charlotte is likely to be quite psychic.

Venus in the Fifth House

5th House: Creativity, having fun, playing with, and mixing with others - the essential social interaction. This is the house of developing life skills that involve contact with company. This house is about developing the skills to become popular, confident, and socially accepted. This house also relates strongly with children.

Charlotte has Venus in the Fifth House, which gives a very appealing and romantic nature, with a general love of life. These children are popular and well liked, but they can be quite demanding and bossy too. They like to be 'in charge'. They just love to be in the spotlight and will work hard to get there. Charlotte will like activities which indulge the senses. These children like to feel good and they like to perform. Personal choice will always revolve around 'fun'. There could be artistic ability here, but even if Charlotte does not have any artistic talent, there will be an appreciation of art and music as hobbies.

Charlotte can be a little one-eyed and be too selective when it comes to extending much energy. Remember this child wants to be the star, and can be reluctant to apply effort if there are no shining rewards. There can be some inertia and lack of interest if there is no personal agenda. This area could need some work. Try encouraging this little one to think of others a bit more, and not be so reluctant to work in as part of the team. Charlotte must be taught this early. These traits can spoil an otherwise sunny and infectious personality. It is important to Charlotte to be popular, well liked, and socially acceptable. There will be a willingness to learn to be even 'better' than ever, so Charlotte will take all the helpful hints on board.

In adulthood, this person could well work with children. There is an ability to 'get through' to children. Venus in the fifth house does indicate a Peter Pan of sorts. These types often seem to never get 'old'. The playful nature does not fade with time.

Charlotte will be more than a little attracted to the opposite sex when the hormones kick in. This can be an utterly charming flirt who will prefer the opposite sex as constant company. This child will be quite magnetic and have no trouble attracting their share of admirers, so choice should not be a problem.

Mars in Sagittarius

Mars is essentially the "I am" in us. It is the "I -me -and -mine" - the basic, subjective ego. It is our energy, our initiative, and our drive. It is our aggression, our

temperament, and our passion. Mars is the physical side of our psyche. A strong Mars makes for great sports people because they will be competitive with a real desire to win. Later in life, Mars indicates our sex drive.

This is a fiery little planet, so a strong Mars is a "fiery" little person who runs on high octane - one who will never know when to stop. The "water signs" can dilute this energy somewhat, or can perhaps drive the passion inward. The "fire" will then not be so obvious. However, once we get the hang of our Mars sign, it is an important part of us. It is the fuel on which we run.

Charlotte has Mars in the sign of Sagittarius. This child will be the self appointed defender of the people. They are the ones to stand up and fight for any cause they believe in. These youngsters "think big." Charlotte will love the outdoors. Being outdoors gives this child a real sense of freedom and this is a good outlet for their abundant physical energy. This feeling of freedom is very important to them. They need the fresh air and they just love the wide-open spaces. In fact, Charlotte will rebel against any sort of restriction. There will be a sheer fascination and love of adventure. Their fondness for animals, especially horses will be strong. These kids love to learn, but they do have a tendency to scatter their energies and try to take on too much. Their attention span will be short. Although their interests will be many, getting these little ones to finish a project can be an up-hill battle. Charlotte will be quite outspoken, often lacking diplomacy, but that sparkling personality is so pleasant and so loveable that this trait seldom draws offence.

It is rather common to find excellent athletes with this placement. These youngsters often succeed because they just do not think much about failing. They are energetic, determined, and they LOVE to win. Charlotte will also be there to make sure everyone is fairly treated. The natural instinct will be to play by the rules. This is the sign of the true sportsperson in every sense of the word.

This child's actions are motivated by their ideals. Charlotte will work for a principle but it must be considered important. These kids do not like to waste their energy on something that does not matter a lot to them. If Charlotte is working as part of a group, the mundane stuff will not be a priority. Their task of choice will be at the front where the action is. Charlotte will do anything that needs doing, willingly, but will resist being forced to do anything at all. There's that freedom thing again. As this child develops, you will find that high moral standards and high ideals motivate them above everything else.

With the onset of puberty, Charlotte will be fascinated with the idea of a brand new era that needs to be explored. Interest in the opposite sex will certainly start quite young. This whole transition for Charlotte should be relatively comfortable and at the same time, quite exciting. And one more thing - even though they love the chase, they can be difficult to catch.

Mars in the Second House

2nd House: This House is about values and possessions. It is the "my things" attitude. It is where nourishment is needed to feel confident and secure. This House is about experiencing the sensual fundamentals in order to feel fulfilled and loved. This House puts a real value on tangible assets and it is where real fears are born with respect to deprivation. It is also where we learn to provide for ourselves if we must. It is where we discover our "comfort zone".

This child with Mars in the second house will be of the slow and steady variety. Charlotte will not like to be rushed. However, the attention span will be good and this child will plod through and produce good, solid results.

Charlotte will be very interested in amassing as much as possible. When these children see something that they want, they will want it very much. And they will work hard to get it. Charlotte will probably be great at saving pocket money, and will then buy their goodies independently. This child may insist on having complete control over their spending power. They need to be taught early on to reject a sudden impulse to just go and get whatever it is that they want. The "solid and steady" tag does not apply to acquiring assets. It should be suggested that Charlotte think things through, and to decide whether they truly do want something. Any interference will be met with disdain, because Charlotte will have very set views. But because of the compulsive nature of Mars, these kids are quite likely to be careless with money. This impulsiveness to "own" can become a big problem. Charlotte will have a very strong sense of ownership and anyone who challenges this will stir up a real anger. This is a lesson better learned while young.

These children may not be absolutely selfish, but they will want to share only on their own terms, not because they have to. If a brother or sister takes something without asking, this youngster will really blow up. And there will be real fireworks if someone damages something of theirs. Charlotte may be careless, but no one else can be. This will particularly apply to personal belongings. Help Charlotte to learn to be less possessive. A possessive attitude can cause toys and belongings to bring more pain than pleasure, keeping Charlotte from fully enjoying them.

Jupiter in Pisces

Jupiter is a slower moving planet that stays in the same sign for about a year. Its sign has a direct personal effect only when it is in close aspect to the Ascendant or Midheaven, or forms a strong aspect with one of the personal planets. Jupiter is the planet of expansion, growth, and often, luck.

The house position of Jupiter relates to areas of life in which we will want to grow. It shows the area in which we are likely to think positively and optimistically. In a general sense, things work well for us in the house that Jupiter occupies. The keyword for Jupiter is expansion. That can be physically, mentally, or spiritually. Jupiter's position can relate to the expansion of assets relating to financial freedom, or perhaps, even, weight.

Charlotte has Jupiter in Pisces. This child is a real idealist. There will be beautiful dreams and a great sense of fantasy. Charlotte would like everything to be perfect and glorious, often going in search of Utopia without even knowing it. And then become bitterly disappointed when reality does not live up to expectations.

Charlotte is a little romantic who will be the eternal optimist. There will be an attraction to the mystical. These kids are gentle and compassionate. They will love to help and will tend to put the interests of others first. This can cause a few problems because these kids are usually on a very deep personal search themselves. They will have to learn to take some personal time and space, and not feel guilty, not feel like a martyr, because this child can easily slip into this role and resent it. Much as they will always love to "give", they must learn to give of themselves only what they actually feel good about giving, and not feel under any obligation to give and not know how to receive in return. This is the sign of the Good Samaritan. With maturity Charlotte will develop a strong spiritual awareness although may not subscribe to orthodox views.

Even as children these kids will need to go off alone now and then and wallow in their thoughts. The pace of the everyday world can be confusing. In private, Charlotte can have some of the most important experiences and personal growth spurts. These are visionary and intuitive people who also have a strong need to find their own path in life. They will be looking for answers and for truth. Charlotte will not be particularly materialistic and may not be particularly ambitious in the general sense of the word.

Jupiter in the Fourth House

4th House: The early home environment. The Mother influence. Early development.

Charlotte has Jupiter in the Fourth House. This usually shows a childhood environment and home that is very positive. It often indicates that this child will receive a great deal of emotional support from the parents and family. In general, the early life should

provide a solid basis giving a great deal of self-confidence and assurance. In particular, one of the parents is likely to be very influential. Even if the family is not well to do, the home will be comfortable and pleasant. This will give Charlotte a lifelong taste for comfortable and elegant surroundings, perhaps always choosing to live in a home that is much larger than what is really needed. But sharing with others will be a priority and the natural instinct is to extend a warm hospitality to all and everyone.

These kids can become very fond of collecting things. Consequently, they may live in a clutter that is almost impossible to deal with. All these possessions will end up dictating if this is allowed to happen.

In adulthood, Charlotte may want to own a great deal of land. Real estate transactions can be very successful, although this person is unlikely to speculate. They will know the value of money too well to gamble or take a chance. Prosperity is often a matter of course later in life.

Saturn in Sagittarius

There are always two sides of Saturn - what is, and what can be. Saturn stays in the same sign for approximately two and a half years, so all of the children born around the same time as Charlotte will show the same characteristics. Saturn in the sign is therefore personal only when forming one or more aspect(s) with the personal planets, the Ascendant, or the Midheaven.

Read these aspects thoroughly to be more aware of Saturn and what it has to teach this child.

Saturn is all about progress, but it is the slow and sure progress - nothing happens guickly with this rather severe planet. This is where we learn the art of survival. Saturn makes us stop, look, and listen and not go rushing in. This is where we come up against brick walls, where we have to review the lessons learned and modify the next move. Saturn makes us accept responsibility, accept a challenge, and move forward. Saturn is the reason behind many of our fears, our sense of guilt and our sense of failure, but, again, when we beat these obstacles, we are so much wiser and stronger. The House in which Saturn falls signifies the areas where life can be tough. Nothing seems to come easily, and yet the prospects are of significance. This is the area where our fears will have to be addressed, and where our confidence will need to be lifted. Discipline and patience will be badly needed here in order for us to gain control. It is where we must stop and think, but ultimately we learn from Saturn - he is a great teacher. Saturn is often related to the father figure, or the "authority" figure that influences Charlotte. Difficult aspects with Saturn often indicate problems in this area. Saturn often sounds rather negative which is not accurate. Consider Saturn as a hurdle that is there to be conquered - not as an obstacle to fear.

Charlotte has the planet, Saturn, in bold sign of Sagittarius. Saturn puts some limitations on the exuberant Sagittarius. The attitude will be quite serious. The ethical and moral approach to life will always be very strong, in fact, almost staunch.

These kids will have quite a deep and penetrating mind but will put a whole lot of thought into their work and theories. Once an idea is formed, the attitude can be dogmatic with a stubborn reluctance to expand or move on those opinions. So much effort goes in to reaching a conclusion that Charlotte will be horrified to think that even the smallest point could have been missed. There can be an almost self-righteous approach to life and philosophies.

Charlotte will live by a set of principles that are very high. There will be a natural respect for authority and the establishment. The basic belief structure will be in tune with traditional. Later in life, Charlotte could need to face a major challenge with religious or philosophical views.

The ambition will be to learn and to reach out intellectually, but the necessary openings might not come easily. Maybe Charlotte is too hesitant to grab the chances that crop up,

or perhaps the right time and the right place just simply does not happen. Reputation is very important.

This combination can be helped with encouragement to broaden the outlook. Teach Charlotte that true learning comes from an open mind and being receptive to alternative ideas. If this child can widen those horizons and reach for the stars, the intellectual mind will be as expansive and as limitless as the universe that is out there.

Saturn in the Second House

2nd House: This House is about values and possessions. It is the "my things" attitude. It is where nourishment is needed to feel confident and secure. This House is about experiencing the sensual fundamentals in order to feel fulfilled and loved. This House puts a real value on tangible assets and it is where real fears are born with respect to deprivation. It is also where we learn to provide for ourselves if we must. It is where we discover our "comfort zone".

Charlotte has the planet Saturn in the Second House. This kid can be the proverbial squirrel - feeling as though there is never enough "nuts" to last through the winter. These kids will hang on to any pocket money, birthday money, or whatever for as long as they can, "just in case" they need it later. Money and security is important, and this little one will be quite prepared to work to earn their cash. It could be that they are taught to be very thrifty from a young age out of sheer need, but it is more likely that there is just a natural fear - or terror even - of being deprived. Caution in the area of money or other resources will always apply simply through being afraid there will not be enough.

Charlotte does have to learn that security actually comes from within. It is confidence and the survival instinct that will carry anyone through the lean or tough times. It is a mental approach rather than a monetary approach. Being so afraid can actually bring about a sense of deprivation and poverty.

On the positive side, this makes a very careful planner. Charlotte will not take anything for granted or expect anything for nothing. The preference actually is to work for goals, which does make these people feel good. A pride should be taken in what will be significant achievements. So as long as Charlotte can grow enough to develop a solid sense of self worth, the financial gains will be appreciated and used to make a comfortable life. Working hard may not be an option. Money does not come easily, in general terms, to someone with Saturn in the 2nd House.

Uranus in Sagittarius

Uranus is a huge planet that has the reputation for causing all sorts of chaos. Uranus has a mind of its own; racing around in space on its side and with an orbit that is unpredictable. Uranus is very difficult to spot with the naked eye. Similarly, the Uranian traits are quite difficult to 'spot'.

This 'cranky' planet brings change - unexpected, sudden and completely disruptive change. It can be the source of disasters or miracles. The function of Uranus is to disrupt our view of reality, and give us an alternative view beyond the known and the visible. Uranus provides sudden flashes of insight and creative genius, as well as practiced eccentricity. Uranus has the ability to shake up the comfort of the 'norm' and catapult us into a rather scary future.

This planet stays in each sign for about 7 years so is considered one of the slow movers. The qualities that stem from the sign that Uranus is in will affect all of the children in the same era as Charlotte. As the slow moving planets move from sign to sign, the differences will be subtle, but they will loosely apply to the philosophy and the attitudes of the child concerned.

Uranus in the House is a whole lot more personal. This will be where Charlotte will display a uniqueness of character. It will be where the intuition is heightened, and the need to be 'different' will be apparent. It can be the area where Charlotte is subjected to major changes and disruptions over which there is no control. The issues that apply to the house that Uranus falls in can involve a lifetime struggle to conquer and understand.

Uranus in Sagittarius (1981-1988). Uranus is a planet concerned with sudden changes. Sagittarius is the sign of the intellectual who seeks truth. These children will be the philosophers who question the establishment and the monumental structures. They will challenge beliefs and traditions, being much more interested in the new and the innovative. The eye will be on future improvements rather than staying in the past. This bunch of children will be very much in touch with the modern age of technology and will love it. They will also be acutely aware of the inequality throughout the world. The eye will be sincerely on protecting our planet for the future and on the good of all 'mankind'. However, much as the dreams will be genuine and bold, they may not be practical. These children will be proactive and innovative, but the minor details, and workable solutions, could be a job for the next generation.

A sense of prophecy coupled with intuition and a "big" optimism could see a lot of energy being put into improving the lot of the under-privileged. Many of these people will have sound judgement - because they do look at the broad picture. But an important ingredient will be a need for total freedom of expression. True tenacity and dedication could be fleeting.

Many of these people will be drawn to the more modern religious sects rather than to the orthodox beliefs. However, faith will be strong within many of these people.

Uranus in the Second House

2nd House: This House is about values and possessions. It is the "my things" attitude. It is where nourishment is needed to feel confident and secure. This House is about experiencing the sensual fundamentals in order to feel fulfilled and loved. This House puts a real value on tangible assets and it is where real fears are born with respect to deprivation. It is also where we learn to provide for ourselves if we must. It is where we discover our "comfort zone".

Charlotte has the erratic planet Uranus in the 2nd house. These children will seem to have little or no practical sense when it comes to money or possessions. It will be easy come and easy go for Charlotte. From an early age, it will need to be taught that we do need to be careful and protect what we have. We must 'look after' our possessions. Charlotte is likely to lose interest in toys, books and clothes in a matter of minutes, and so wander off leaving any 'goodies' behind. Try to teach this child to budget out the pocket money and consider tomorrow. It is unlikely that Charlotte will ever be materialistic, but downright carelessness can be cured. The 'things' and possessions that do matter will be quite unusual. Try to extract the same interest in practical issues. These children are excitable, independent and can be very stubborn. Charlotte will have some strange tastes in food.

As an adult Charlotte will probably not want to accumulate a whole lot of assets, preferring a life with little clutter that allows freedom to up and move at a minute's notice. A future career could well involve travel. Or equally the eventual career choice could be downright 'odd'. These children do like to be different. But the adult life can be fraught with fluctuating finances with the erratic planet Uranus in the 2nd house. However, this is a strong and loyal friend who will be trustworthy and a tower of strength in times of need. Charlotte may be rather different, but there will be a certain natural contentment that will be enviable.

Neptune in Capricorn

Neptune is a vast and remote planet believed to be a very watery place. This giant lumbers through the heavens slowly, so Neptune in the sign is considered very generational. All kids born in the same era as Charlotte will have this similarity. To take on any personal meaning there needs to be a close affiliation with one of the personal planets, the Ascendant, or the Midheaven.

Neptune is a mysterious planet. It covers all areas of creativity, the imagination, illusion and also deception. Neptune casts a watery haze that can enhance the sheer beauty involved, or it can distort the picture entirely. Being associated with water and moving in the realms of the subconscious, Neptune seems to water down inner confidence. The strength that radiates is inner strength that is fine for the experienced adult, but it can

seem of little use to the vulnerable child. Hence, escapism, drugs, alcohol, oppressive sects, and even isolated institutions are associated with Neptune.

Neptune in strong position enhances artistic vision and sense of imagery. It drives at all possible sensitivities in the highest degree.

When Neptune is in a strained position, reality gets fuddled causing confusion and deception. The true value of Neptune dissolves old patterns for new, but this is quite an obscure occurrence with little logic to explain it. It is a deep and personal learning curve that slowly unfolds. It is the stirring deep within the subconscious.

Neptune in the House indicates areas of life that will experience the Neptunian lessons. It will be where we need to adapt on a practical level without losing the gifts of this mystical planet. It can be where we have to suffer in order to grow.

Neptune is idealistic, it is imagination and illusion, and it is mystical. This planet cannot be caught and captured. Neptune rules photography which explains its function well, because it tends to take an image and put it in a different dimension. Neptune is imagery. For a youngster, this can be a very difficult energy to deal with because many of the courses it takes are unclear, vague, but powerful. But this planet is the rainbow that we are blessed with. It is elusive, but it is very beautiful.

Neptune in Capricorn (1985-1998). Neptune is deep, mystical and a little illogical. The sign of Capricorn is ambitious, traditional, and very logical. During this era it is likely that a strong focus will fall on politics, power, and power games. This generation will see scandal and deception within the hallowed walls of government. Politicians will not be so protected - they will be accountable for their private life as well as their public life. Saints and sinners can come out of the woodwork. Big businesses merge and even countries will join to try to improve power. This could be an age of enormous power struggles.

This generation will take a strong interest in the preservation of our planet and its survival. The message will be that we must allow bad habits to dissolve. Respect for nature must be given as a natural and continuing consideration.

Further education becomes the normal for all ages as a practical resource for the future. The acceptance of alternative medicines will grow - but will also be questioned, tested, and made accountable. Clever and practical religious leaders could emerge from this generation.

Neptune in the Third House

3rd House: This House is about early education. It is about mental stimulation that provokes learning through interaction and experience. And then using the lessons. The area for the child is the playground, playgroups and mixing with children the same age. It is about becoming familiar with the local environment and the neighbors. This is essentially the House that is all about communication at its best and its beginnings.

Neptune in the Third House heightens the imagination, which Charlotte will show in all areas of creative communication. Neptune in this House often suggests dealings with the media or with advertising. Poetry, prose, - in fact any sort of inspired word will draw Charlotte. However, there can be a wee problem that needs to be sorted. These kids have to learn to separate truth from fantasy, separate what they want to believe from what they know to be true. Charlotte must be taught to identify the imagination, the logical, and the actual, and then deal with the differences of all areas on an equal footing.

This child, when young, will have some problems with stopping the mind from drifting and wandering. There can even be nervous disorders as there can be deep insecurities in the childhood years. Often there can be rifts with the family at some stage, which could attribute to this "nervousness". This could also attribute to the tendency to fabricate or expand on the truth. It is not always the case, but there is a strong possibility with Neptune in the third House, that lies and deceit do come easily.

These kids can put family members on an unrealistic pedestal rather than accept a less than perfect situation. There are many ways that Charlotte could actually feel deceived and in turn, become deceptive. Obviously, this sensitive kid needs to be taught to accept reality and opt for the inspirational world of fantasy as an adventure and a creative but productive part of the psyche. With this vivid imagination, these children can say a great deal to make others understand. Take the time to allow Charlotte to shake off the negatives and share the positives. Neptune in the third House shows a very intuitive mind, and sometimes, clairvoyant abilities. Charlotte can be too idealistic and quite gullible so must learn not to accept everything so readily.

Pluto in Scorpio

The Planet Pluto is deemed cold, dark, and remote. This planet is closely associated with the cycles of death and rebirth. It is about personal growth. But often there is pain attached - as in "growing pains". Pluto breaks down the old, the worn out and no longer useful portions of life and the world at large, and then it recycles, and rebuilds. Pluto governs the areas where we have to die in order to continue to grow. Where Pluto is in our chart is where we feel a need to control because it is where we will never have control. It is where we need to let go, to let something die, and work

towards rejuvenation. It is our inner search for enlightenment and revolutionary change. It also indicates how we handle power that comes our way, Or in the child, how the influence and power of peers affects the psyche.

The sign that Pluto is in affects whole generations and is important to the individual only if Pluto is in close aspect to the Ascendant or Midheaven or in close aspect to the Sun, Moon or inner planets.

The house placement of Pluto suggests the areas of life that will be the source of greatest change and most intense development. This can be where the child experiences a whole lot of pain due to circumstances of birth - circumstances which the child has no control over. This can be where the child undergoes deep and private reformation. This can be the ugly duckling and the beautiful swan syndrome or perhaps, the caterpillar and the exotic butterfly effect. These enormous changes are motivated from deep within and suddenly materialize.

Pluto in Scorpio (1984-1995). This sign is ruled by Pluto. Education methods come under scrutiny. Psychic research and methods will be accepted and endorsed. There are many far-reaching strides which make significant progress in scientific fields. Many trouble spots across the globe spring up with minority people fighting to survive the global power games. Monetary systems are amalgamated with the power intensified to secure even more control. This period will be a time of change that is intense even by twentieth-century standards.

A sexual revolution comes out of this era. Gay rights are openly fought. Abortion enters the political arena. Euthanasia is given consideration. Ugly power games, even sexual power games become a major issue and shock many of us.

Pluto in the First House

1st House: This powerful House is essentially the outward expression and obvious character traits. It represents the "I, me, and mine" - the ego and the subjective - the "I want" attitude. This House also shows the "I can do" attitude. This is about spontaneous openness, and the inherent qualities that drive the personality.

Charlotte has the powerful planet, Pluto, in the First House so will be very intense taking everything seriously. It is all or nothing - either something has to be so important that this child will have to throw themselves in 100% - or they simply will not bother at all.

Charlotte will have strong will power. The extremes to which this child can go can be quite scary for others who are more relaxed. The approach is full on and packed full of mental and physical energy. The actual presence will be quite powerful - if not over-powering. This child will always push the limits simply to see how far they can go.

Charlotte will need to realize the effect that the personality does have because there will be a strong magnetism. However, these kids have the ability to stir up intense feelings in others. The powerful attraction will be difficult to miss. But this can provoke as much strong dislike as it does respect. Charlotte needs to accept this ability and accept the responsibility. In many ways, these kids can be loners. Friends that are made will be deep and solid with a real base, but these friends will probably be few. Often there is a feeling of being misunderstood, but deep down this is a bit of an enigma. Generally, these are a gentle and very sensitive people. However, when provoked or panicked, there is enormous anger that surfaces.

Conformity is never easy with Pluto in the 1st House. There is often the gift to be able to look back and see the future quite clearly. This broody child will be private and deep. Charlotte will always be quite capable of handling life and all the lessons that are thrown in. The actual "image" projected will be private, but under the surface, there will be continual changing and growing. Charlotte will have the ability to lead but will have to take care to aim for objective results rather than be totally subjective.

Planets in Aspect

EXPLANATION OF THE ASPECTS

An explanation of the Aspects: These are very important in any natal chart. It is when 2 or more planets "make connection" with each other. To be of significance, the "orb" or degree of this connection, must be relatively close. All the Aspects are of significance, but some are more powerful than are others. And, of course, they all have different meanings.

All of the aspects that are relevant are automatically listed in order of strength. Obviously, the higher the strength the more relevant and potent the aspect.

Conjunction: A powerful and dynamic aspect. This is when two or more planets are sitting right next to each other and they will either back each other up, or compete against each other. Being in the same sign and same house adds up to a lot of weight.

Trine: A distance of 120-degrees between any planet forms a "Trine". These planets will be in the same Element so they will blend well and flow. The Trine brings comfort, ease, and benefit with little effort.

Sextile: The distance between any planets involved in a "Sextile" is 60 degrees. This aspect brings the opportunity to be productive or creative. But the energy of the Sextile must be used - it will not just "happen" Both planets will fall in either Masculine or Feminine signs, so they are compatible.

Square: There will be a 90-degree separation between any planets involved in a "Square". Here is an indication of obstacles and stress that need to be worked through. The planets "square off" against each other but - these are personal learning curves of life. These are hurdles for us to jump but through them we learn and grow. The lessons from Squares tend to be subjective. These aspects will be in signs of the same quality.

Opposition: As the name suggests, any planets that form an "opposition" will be smack, bang opposite each other at 180-degrees apart. This is where one learns to compromise and give a little. The opposition usually involves other people. These lessons are quite objective. Being in polar opposite signs of the zodiac, these planets mirror each other.

Inconjunct also known as the Quincunx: This is considered a "minor" aspect but is about our personal growth and long-term development in the area of the personality. It shows us our limitations and how we can expand a little. The distance between the two

celestial bodies here will be 150 degrees apart. Being relatively minor, the orb used is generally rather tight. This aspect would be almost exact to rate in this interpretation.

Venus square Mars (Strength: 5.60)

The Squares are quite subjective. Squares bring challenges that must be worked through.

With Venus, the planet of Love, in square to the energetic little planet Mars, Charlotte could have a few simple things to learn quite early in life. Remember, that is the object of a 'square' - to learn the lesson that it dishes out.

These children have a special need to have a warm and close relationship with the parent of the opposite sex. This is where they learn their basic skills in interaction. They have a solid idea on what they think that a relationship, or love, should involve, and as a child there is a great need to have these ideas reinforced. If the home environment is stormy, they will accept that all relationships have to be a series of swings and roundabouts to be successful, and that is what they will create in all their future associations. It will be the sincere belief that a relationship has to be turbulent to be real. This is how Charlotte will understand 'love', and before long, the emotional or physical bruises will simply drive a loved one away. Be very aware that this child will follow by example.

The emotions here are intense. Charlotte will either love or hate. If they 'love', it will be a very powerful love, but if they dislike someone, they will be completely indifferent. They will ignore that person and can be quite obnoxious if they want to be. Opinions will be very rigid.

If this square is not taken seriously, it can lead to physical violence - but only if there is an unresolved problem in the relationship with that parent of the opposite sex. If that relationship is secure, this simply indicates that this child will have an intense and passionate nature. And Charlotte will certainly be attracted to, and become involved with the opposite sex at an early age.

Moon conjunct Midheaven (Strength: 4.98)

The conjunction adds emphasis to the power, the energy, and the vitality of the planets involved by the close proximity.

Charlotte has the emotional Moon high in the sky, in conjunction to the Midheaven. This child will be sensitive to the feelings of others and the emotions will be very powerful. Charlotte will seem to be able to reach out and touch people, gain their trust and their

confidence, and in many ways influence how people feel. This can be quite a charismatic little person who will have no fear of taking responsibility. Charlotte will be quite comfortable being rather "public" and standing up for principles.

What happens while these kids are young will have a very strong effect on their future life. Attitudes or habits that Charlotte learns in the earliest years will be part of a very solid foundation. It is also likely that the career choice will be greatly influenced by these childhood ideals. The Mother could have an impact on the choice that Charlotte makes. It is important that this relationship is healthy and rounded, because Charlotte does need this influence and this base. Without this support, ambition will be dampened, and it will badly affect setting any goals in life. Charlotte truly does need the emotional support of the Mother figure very much.

In some way, this child probably will receive a great deal of help from others, especially women, but Charlotte will have to work to make the best of it.

Charlotte should operate well within large organizations or even working with the general public, because there is the ability to communicate on a broad level in a powerful way. It might be in advertising or public relations, or politics, perhaps. Equally, the profession might involve taking care of others. But Charlotte is almost bound to utilize the clever sensitivity that emerges in childhood and blossoms in the adult years.

Sun conjunct Jupiter (Strength: 4.30)

The conjunction adds emphasis to the power, the energy, and the vitality of the planets involved by the close proximity.

Charlotte has the Sun and Jupiter in conjunction which is a very valuable influence. The Sun is the basic personality, and Jupiter expands on everything it touches. Here you have a BIG personality. Charlotte will be outgoing, confident, warm, and generous. These kids can be very extravagant, very big-hearted, and can tend to overdo just about everything. They can be overconfident. They can take risks that can be alarming, but these kids feel that they are invincible. There is a need to try to encourage just a bit of caution. Often the home environment is very comfortable, so these fortunate kids have everything laid on. Their lives are simply one of ease.

Charlotte can have an over-inflated sense of self worth. It will be easy for this personality to become quite smug and egotistical. There could be a need to put this child in its place from time to time. This will be accepted because there is a strong sense of justice and the need to be liked and admired. It would never be the intention to offend or take advantage of anyone. Most of the time, this child will be a delight. They will be one of the "good kids", but coax them into understanding that they do not have to "prove" themselves all of the time.

There is bound to be a great love of travel especially as this child grows up. One thing Charlotte will never fear, and that is any lack of friends. The vital personality will always make this a popular person.

Venus square Saturn (Strength: 4.15)

The Squares are quite subjective. Squares bring challenges that must be worked through.

With Venus, the planet of love, in square to the limitations of the planet Saturn, Charlotte will have to work hard to accept that giving love and receiving love should be easy. These children need a whole lot of reassurance and unconditional love right from the very beginning of their life. They need to be taught to give and receive hugs and cuddles, to give and receive praise, to learn to develop some self-confidence. Saturn drains these natural fundamentals for Charlotte, so effort is needed to replenish.

These children will often feel that they don't matter. They feel unimportant and tend to switch off. They find it easier to be totally detached rather than run the risk of rejection. But deep down, they have a deep hunger and a deep need to be loved and be able to love. They become very cold and remote out of a real fear of rebuff and a sense of inadequacy. However, with plenty of emotional support and physical affirmation of love, the confidence will develop. Charlotte will be simply shy, but not afraid.

These children have to learn that you win some, and you lose some, and that's life. It is not personal. That is just the way that it is. They may well have difficulty in expressing their feelings even when they badly want to. But with encouragement, Charlotte will learn. More than anything else, this little one needs to have confidence. Gaining this confidence could well involve extra nourishment from parents and loved ones from a very early age.

Mars conjunct Saturn (Strength: 3.75)

The conjunction adds emphasis to the power, the energy, and the vitality of the planets.

Charlotte has the energetic planet Mars Conjunct the planet Saturn, which gives a very serious side to the character. These kids seem to be born weighed down with heavy responsibilities. Charlotte will rarely waste energies on unproductive activities. Any moves will be well planned out and will be given the utmost concentration. These kids have the capacity for hard work and can make "hard work" out of any project.

This combination does suggest a lack confidence. Saturn can apply to the father figure or an authoritative figure - so this aspect can suggest that Charlotte feels a need to please at any price. Maybe too much is expected. Maybe a big, strong, authoritative figure is too critical. Often these kids set such high goals that they automatically feel like a failure when efforts do not succeed. Bear this in mind. Charlotte will work very hard to please and impress adults, so remember to give credit and praise where it is due. Anger will be suppressed with this aspect; it can build up for years. But anger always needs somewhere to go. These kids can easily develop a defeatist attitude causing deep frustration. This frustration will need an outlet. A good way for Charlotte to do this is to express the negative thoughts on paper - writing or drawing perhaps. Nevertheless, this child does need to learn to get rid of anger that builds up. Charlottecan give up and stop trying. Try to "read" the depths here. Try to encourage Charlotte to feel free to explain frustrations or fears. Good old-fashioned communication can work wonders in developing this child. So obviously, some clever and tender nurturing is needed to bring out the positives of this aspect.

When the difficult years of puberty hit, a sense of inner confidence and self-esteem will make things a little easier for Charlotte. However, if there are unresolved issues, this will badly affect the ease with which this child will relate to the opposite sex. These kids tend to feel intimidated by the physical changes and take on board a whole lot of unnecessary guilt. Charlotte will feel out of control and confused by such depth of feelings. Make sure that Charlotte knows that this is an exciting period of growth and quite natural. Odd things do happen. Strange urges do take over the logic and the sensibility, but that is Ok. Communications need to be open, honest, and uncomplicated on the subject of "growing up". Charlotte must be able to express any confusion in a relaxed and unconditional way.

Charlotte will have the strength, the stamina, and the resourcefulness to succeed. There will be extraordinary powers of concentration. Charlotte will have a keen eye for detail and the patience to see a project through. These kids are very disciplined. But all kids need to have fun too. Charlotte does need to be helped through the difficulties that this aspect can cause and learn to go with the positives. The planet Saturn weighs heavy - but there is always a silver lining attached. Charlotte has to learn to look for it.

Moon inconjunct Jupiter (Strength: 3.20)

The inconjunct (quincunx) involves the willpower and the areas where our "thinking patterns" need some work.

Having the Moon inconjunct Jupiter should give Charlotte a positive and optimistic outlook on life, but the aspect can also account for this child being a trifle self-indulgent. Also, sometimes the sights are set too high, the expectations are simply not possible, and this causes frustration for Charlotte. If this happens, show how to recognize what is

possible and what is not. Charlotte is not super-human and so could need to learn to take the pressure off. Besides, once a goal has been achieved, the joy of succeeding should help reduce the frustration.

These kids seem to come into this world looking on the bright side of life, but they do have a great need to be accepted, loved and supported for who they are. Charlotte will need to have a strong rapport with the Mother figure. If the Mother figure is distant or does not give this child her full backing, they can become quite selfish. The child will feel totally insecure. Some people with this aspect stay tied too closely to the Mother even when they are well able to be independent. But, again, with all the right ingredients, the Jupiter influence will be nothing but good. Charlotte will grow up feeling blessed and loved, wanting to share the good fortune. In fact, these kids will get a whole lot of pleasure and satisfaction in simply "giving" to whomever needs their genuine support.

Mercury square Uranus (Strength: 3.01)

The Squares are quite subjective. Squares bring challenges that must be worked through.

With the expressive planet Mercury square the erratic planet Uranus, Charlotte will say whatever comes into the head. These kids will not take too much time to think things through. If they can be guided into learning to control the mental energy, this aspect can be a bit of a bonus.

Charlotte will be attracted to thrilling and exciting ideas. If there is a challenge to be met, Charlotte will be the first out of the starting blocks. There is a natural ability to understand even the most complex procedures. But, the light of curiosity does blind these kids. They see the outcome, but will struggle to work through the process of understanding in order to learn the mechanics. This abstract thinking is clever, but it does not deal with content. Charlotte will go bouncing from one new idea to the next, becoming jack of all trades and master of none. These kids do find it difficult to concentrate. The pace that the mind moves at is incredible, but again, the strategy and true comprehension is sparse.

The quick humor that will develop can be cryptic and, sometimes, caustic. Charlotte will use a unique imagination to its fullest by being shocking just for effect. There is something of the practical joker here, but the timing can be a bit off, so maybe not always appreciated by the recipients. Charlotte will have to learn accept that others may not understand this particular brand of humor.

The communication skills and the word power will undoubtedly be clever, but mental energies can be wasted in temperamental warfare. Charlotte will love a battle of wits

and will take the other side of just about any argument just for the fun of it. This independent mind can make for a real leader, but the best thought-out ideas often never reach completion unless discipline has been instilled early. The art of compromise and a respect for others will help to round off this high spirited, clever kid.

Sun sextile Neptune (Strength: 2.73)

Sextiles bring chances and opportunity. Effort is needed to realize the full potential.

These children with Sun sextile to Neptune are ultra sensitive and will be so easily hurt and bruised. Charlotte will be a gentle child, attuned to pretty music, pretty colors and a tranquil atmosphere. Even a dark look will be misinterpreted and taken personally. These poor kids think they are the source of any discord and have to be taught that this is not so.

This child will reel against anyone who is aggressive and domineering - they will just "give in". But they will quietly get real mad at being manipulated. Charlotte will "feel" very strongly. This is not a wimp. But these kids need to be trained to stand up, say what they think, and not be afraid of the odd argument. When they get upset or angry, they must learn to feel free to express how they feel, not let the frustration build up. There is a big need to develop a lot more confidence. This will need some help from an early age. Confidence is probably not a natural function.

These kids are so tuned in to the personalities around them. They pick up powerful feelings, premonitions, and understanding that can be scary. There could well be psychic or clairvoyant gifts here that could explain why they are reluctant to "say what they think". Maybe they truly do not understand where the thoughts come from. Check this possibility out, as this can be a real source of confusion for such a timid child.

But this is a wonderful aspect for Charlotte to have. In almost any kind of creative activity - art, music or poetry, these kids can see and express ideas that are denied most of us. The imagination is a treasure trail of the mystical and the fantasy. It is no wonder this little one wanders off regularly.

This is also an idealist who would very much like to see a more beautiful and perfect world. Charlotte does have to accept that this world of ours is not perfect - and yet it is still beautiful. Nature itself throws in some odd quirks, but that is how it was meant to be. And that is life and the human race as well. And that's OK. Try to instill a natural blend of inner vision and outer reality that does not destroy this enormous hope that Charlotte is blessed with.

Sun trine Pluto (Strength: 2.70)

Trines bring ease, harmony, and success, which need little effort. They can help creativity.

These kids with the Sun in trine to Pluto are good at communicating. They find it easy to gain the confidence of those around them. They have extremely strong leadership qualities. These children radiate great warmth that is powerful. There will be a charismatic air that will be quite hypnotic.

Charlotte will enjoy doing new things, covering new ground, and trying anything that there is to try, because it helps the realms of understanding. These kids are keenly interested in knowing the mechanics of everything. They will poke and prod until they are satisfied and will never let a chance slip by. These kids have little sense of fear so will be seen to take a few chances. The quest for knowledge includes experiencing as much of life as is possible.

This young person's life may go through quite a few changes, but this will not bother them. Charlotte will badly want to grow intellectually and spiritually. These kids will want to understand themselves thoroughly. With maturity, they will have a sound knowledge of their potential.

This, actually, is the mark of the born healer. These people feel protected and are able to protect others with their gifts. They are able to influence the people around them in a very subtle way. This is all good stuff, but Charlotte should learn to understand the sheer power that is available here and learn how to cope with the possibilities. If this gift is not recognized and used as it should be, it could be so easy for Charlotte to simply use the power part. This would not only be a shame, but Charlotte will instinctively know that there is "a job to do".

Moon square Ascendant (Strength: 2.27)

The Squares are quite subjective. Squares bring challenges that must be worked through.

Charlotte has the emotional Moon square the Ascendant. This makes for an erratic sort of personality. The feelings are quite changeable. Charlotte will be someone's "best friend" one day and then ignore him or her the next day for little or no reason. In many ways, this child is very afraid of being hurt and will build up a protective wall in an attempt to hide the true self. When a friend comes along that is important to Charlotte, this problem magnifies. Charlotte will live in fear of not making the grade or not measuring up so will tend to get very uptight and probably beat a retreat before the

friendship can go sour. Charlotte has a strong sense of failure in the area of relationships. Confidence needs to be instilled from an early age.

These kids do need to stand up for what they believe. However, this precious confidence will need to be built up before they can start to do this and feel safe from that fear of rejection. They need to feel good about themselves, accept that they have a whole lot to give, and accept that a whole lot of people really do find them great company.

Charlotte will always want to be free to "walk away" or take some time out. Make sure this child is not running away because of being afraid. The moods and emotions will always be up and down, but with a certain amount of self-esteem, this should not become a major problem.

Venus trine Pluto (Strength: 2.27)

Trines bring ease, harmony, and success, which need little effort. Can help creativity.

With the romantic planet Venus in trine with the intensity of the planet Pluto, this child will always place a great importance on the people whom they love. Charlotte will take love very seriously. But Charlotte can be in for disappointments when it is found that not everyone has the same passion or sense of commitment that feels so 'normal' to this idealist.

These children can try to control their friends and loved ones. They can be too domineering, but deep down, this child just cares too much. They identify and feel for their loved ones more than most.

Often when a friendship has gone full circle, and the warm 'fuzzies' have worn off, Charlotte will want to hang on. This child will try to rekindle the fire and almost inflict unnecessary pain for the sake of stubbornness. These characteristics will become stronger as Charlotte gets older and more involved with 'one-to-one' relationships. Charlotte will need to be taught early when to let go. Try to explain to Charlotte that friendships change. We all change, and that is growth and natural progress, it is not failure. These children must learn not to take life and people quite so seriously.

These are the sort of children who can fall in love at first sight. This is a true romantic. So, it will be nothing less than exotic flowers, essential oils, and even a violin or two. But Charlotte will have extremely high moral and spiritual standards. Once committed to a relationship it will be wholehearted with the rest of life in mind.

Uranus sextile Ascendant (Strength: 2.03)

Sextiles bring chances and opportunity. Effort is needed to realize the full potential.

Charlotte has Uranus sextile the Ascendant, so will be an outspoken and very independent child with strong and unique ideas - and is one who will demand to be listened to. These children do want to be taken seriously, but can easily get into trouble because of the very outspokenness of their nature. This trait often draws a big fat negative from adults. But this child will say it as they see it.

The mind is very active. Charlotte will like to learn anything new and will tend to think that if something is new - like an idea, or a thing, or a friend - then it has to be better than anything 'old', or 'established'; but these children will have to learn that progress has a start line somewhere. Charlotte will probably always like any new gadget that comes out. Novelty values will always be high on the list of attractions.

These children will like to be around exciting people who offer a challenge in a positive way. A 'best' friend could change frequently, simply to keep the flow of mental stimulation in motion. Later in life, Charlotte will be drawn to rather eccentric and offbeat-type people, and will steer clear of conventional straight-laced types. The latter sort of predictable company will bore these types to tears - especially as they grow up. Where no intellectual challenge is offered, there will be absolutely no interest.

Sun inconjunct Midheaven (Strength: 1.97)

The inconjunct (quincunx) involves the willpower and the areas where our "thinking patterns" need some work.

The child with the Sun inconjunct the MC is in too much of a hurry. These kids want to start at the top rather than start at the beginning and work their way through. Charlotte will probably struggle with the routine things in life. The eye will always be focused on results. Charlotte may have to learn that all things take time - especially growing up. Coax this child into enjoying childhood. Enjoy being young, not trying to prove something the whole time. Teach this ambitious and impatient child that tomorrow is another day, and if a goal cannot be achieved today, so what! There is plenty of time. These kids need to actually enjoy what they are doing - rather than constantly reaching for a result.

It is important that Charlotte learns to use a bit of patience early in life. Going at breakneck speed brings about a lot of mistakes which can wreck the confidence. The conclusion will be that nothing they do works, and this child will then think, "why bother?" If these kids can learn to see and accept the cause and effect, it will all eventually make sense. This will be a valuable lesson that has been learned.

There is likely to be some niggling tension with the parents with this aspect, but it should all be relatively minor. In many ways this is simply the competitive nature coming to the fore. Charlotte is actually learning to make decisions based on personal findings and not to be afraid to state an opinion. However, as a young child, the resentment could run high for a few years. Put it all down to a glorious learning curve.

Pluto square Midheaven (Strength: 1.73)

The Squares are quite subjective. Squares bring challenges that must be worked through.

Charlotte has the powerful planet, Pluto, square Midheaven. This little person will be very ambitious and will want to make a mark on the world. They do have to learn from a very early age not to trample everyone on their way to get what they want. These kids can be ruthless. Charlotte will need to be taught to respect others. The instinct can be to simply use friends and acquaintances as a tool for personal gain. The ambition is great and the determination to succeed will be a driving force, but life will be lacking without an ability to share. Try to train Charlotte to be forthright and up front. Try to train the eye to look inwardly and see what others see.

With maturity, the natural psychologist will emerge. Charlotte will have a deep understanding of human nature - but again must not use this as a power thing. It will serve as a very useful gift but should not be used as a weapon. As long as Charlotte can learn to be a bit humble, learn to love, share and care, - success will be realized.

But these kids can easily become too ambitious and too ruthless. This can be the personality of a control freak. This can bring a lot of enemies and be the cause of relationships and friendships breaking down.

Jupiter trine Ascendant (Strength: 1.55)

Trines bring ease, harmony, and success, which need little effort. Can help creativity.

Charlotte has the big planet Jupiter Trine the Ascendant: These kids are fun loving and gregarious. They will always be optimistic and have a great sense of humor. They will not be beyond playing jokes on others - in good-natured fun - not to offend. These kids will like to go to parties and all that social stuff. They will especially enjoy being the life of the party whenever possible. In fact, these fun loving kids can sometimes find it difficult to face the serious side of life when they have to. These types never expect life to come out wrong.

Charlotte should get along well at school because the charm will be poured on which will win any teacher over. However, the sense of fun can turn into disruption at times too. But this personality will mean no malice so the hi-jinx will not cause any major dramas. And besides, there is a serious student here who will love to learn. These children will be very curious, wanting to know the answers to as many questions as possible. While they are quite young, the questions will start, and will probably never stop.

In adulthood, Charlotte may want to travel widely. There will be a fascination with the big wide world. This youngster will not want to be tied down to one place forever.

Sun square Saturn (Strength: 0.82)

The Squares are quite subjective. Squares bring challenges that must be worked through.

Charlotte has the Sun squared off to Saturn which is not an easy aspect. For a starter, this is often the sign of the perfectionist, a person who sets such high standards that a sense of failure is almost guaranteed. These types naturally judge themselves too harshly. Charlotte will have a lot of difficulty being satisfied with anything productive or personal.

There can be a problem with authority figures. For example, there may be the feeling that the Father figure (or a similar role model) is too strict or too remote. Charlotte will probably learn to keep all feelings closely guarded because of this influence, especially deep, sensitive, and personal feelings. Some part of this child's life may be hard. The real problem though is that this little one is hard on itself. Other people only reinforce this inherent negative attitude.

However, there is a positive side of this aspect. These kids become survivors capable of coping with most of life's pressures. When Charlotte does start looking at life with more detachment, the ability to be capable and sensible will be a strong asset. Nothing will faze these kids. They will have a strong sense of discipline with a realistic attitude. Generally, this is a good combination for later success.

But try to train this serious child to always look at what they have accomplished rather than what they have not. Teach Charlotte to see that the self-imposed standards are impossible for anyone reach. Acknowledge any achievements with gusto. Give this child an early taste of accepting success with pride.

DOMINANT PLANET(S)

The prominence of the Planets and the contacts that they make with each other define the strongest Planet(s) in the Natal Chart. Some planets make a lot of "noise" which you will see in the area of the "Aspects" whilst some are just waiting for something to happen. The following are considered the Powerhouse Planets and their meetings and positions add a further dimension to the attitudes and aptitudes of Charlotte.

There can be more than one "strongest planet" in which case the person will have a natural ability to dance to many tunes - they will be adaptable and versatile. But if one planet or luminary comes through as the absolute leader, then the person will be very specifically made up of the flavor of that celestial body.

Sun Dominant (Strength: 20.39)

The Sun is technically a star - a big, bold, invigorating star that essentially marks our individuality and drives our willpower. It is the light of our lives. When the Sun is predominant in the Natal Chart, the child will have an abundant personality that will literally be blinding. They have the natural ability to bring the sunshine into a room with them. Charlotte will radiate true warmth.

These kids will be natural, creative, and magnetic but can be puffed up in their own selfimportance too. Self-esteem is all-important, and although Charlotte will have plenty of confidence, the ego is a hungry ego - it will be continually looking for nourishment. Like the sunlight itself, Charlotte can dazzle. But when the shadows fall, what you see and what you get can be two different things. These bright young things can promise but not be able to deliver, although the original intention would always have been honorable.

This child can also overheat at times and will blow the odd fuse but will never hold a grudge. They will cool down quickly. The Sun is closely associated with Leo, and the predominantly Sun person will want to be the Star of the show. Charlotte will want to shine. These are very warm-blooded creatures. They need to be able to give and receive love freely.

These proud kids command respect and wilt if seriously challenged or ignored.

Charlotte will be ambitious but will get there with dignity and charm rather than serious push and shove. These children will maneuver their way to stardom. They will be very fair and honest and will genuinely love people.

Moon Dominant (Strength: 19.12)

The Moon is actually a satellite of planet Earth, so this makes it a very powerful connection. The Moon waxes, wanes, and goes through many phases each month; the true Moon person expresses these phases as moods. The Moon has no light of its own. It absorbs the Sun's rays and bounces a shadowy beam. The true Moon person absorbs and reflects.

Charlotte will reflect the "Mother" image. The family bonds will be very strong and the nurturing nature will be sympathetic and very caring. These children will remember everything from their very earliest childhood, with their feelings and their sensitivities. The Moon can cast some beautiful images and some distorted shadows. Charlotte, with a predominant Moon influence, can be difficult to gauge. But these kids can also have quite a lot of difficulty understanding how the mind works. Consequently, the image that is projected is rather mysterious.

A predominant "Moon" chart has a rare sense of beauty and a deep sensitivity. Charlotte can also pick up the wrong end of the stick. This child can take a totally subjective stance and hang on to it, blindly refusing to admit that they are wrong. They will revert to their emotions, get moody and broody, and probably sulk, rather than reach for logic. The Moon to a large degree, is the base personality, our instinctive emotional response. The Moon is the part of us that others feel. The Moon is the vibration through which we feel. But this satellite of Earth is also highly intuitive. These kids must learn to trust their instincts because these instincts are very accurate. The Moon often indicates a psychic ability.

Charlotte will be emotional, will be easily hurt, and will be moody. But Charlotte will also be loving, loyal, and very genuine.

Midheaven Dominant (Strength: 15.78)

The MC, or the Mid Heaven, is considered to be the absolute top of the Chart. It is the mountain peak. It is the "dizzy heights to which we aspire". It is where we find fame or notoriety. It is the impact that we have on other people. It is our reputation, status, and our standing in the world or in our own community. In the child's chart, it is how their peers accept them.

With such a powerful MC, Charlotte will not be a shrinking violet. This child will be easily recognized in its own way by those in authority. Charlotte will make a definite mark during school life and through adulthood. This child may not set the world on fire or become a public figure, but this is always possible with this powerful energy being to the fore of this chart. Charlotte will be the sort of person who leaves a lasting impression. These kids may have to work hard to gain recognition, or it could be slow coming,

depending on the aspects that come in touch with the MC, but there will always be a strong fate that cannot be ignored.

Many people with a powerful MC do have a very definite job to do on earth. This can be very local and seemingly small, but significant. Or it can be of a far greater magnitude. Deep down there will be a conscious need for this child to "do something" and they will never be content to be totally anonymous.

It should be noted that within Astrology there are many different House systems in use, the majority of which have the MC and the 10th House cusp as one and the same. The writer personally uses the "equal house system" to which this does not apply. In the "equal house system" the MC can fall in the 9th or 10th House - and in extreme latitudes, in the 8th or 11th House. In the 9th House, it is considered that the child will spend time in University where they will study and gain qualifications before embarking on a profession. In the 10th House, the MC indicates more that the child will "learn on the job" when they leave school. The less common 8th House MC suggests that achievement will be hard to come by with many setbacks and not a lot of help in the career stakes. In the 11th House, career changes will be many and the person will have difficulty finding just what they want to do in life

DOMINANT SIGN(S)

The Strongest sign often coincides with that of the Sun in the Natal Chart because Mercury is the Sun's closest companion - they are never far apart. Venus also sticks quite closely to the mighty Sun, and to a lesser degree, Mars never strays too far away. So, one or more of these planets are often in the same sign as the Sun at birth adding further strength.

However, in many cases the "outer" planets can gang up and create a very strong, but quite a different, influence. This area of the Chart will either add more weight to the color and personality of this Child or it could add a further hue to their approach and intensity.

If there is more that one "strongest sign", which is likely, the person will have various facets to their approach and abilities, and so will scatter their energies somewhat. If there is one singleton sign, which outweighs the rest, Charlotte will be more easily recognized by the attributes of the sign involved.

Pisces Dominant (Strength: 204.55)

Pisces, the sign of the Fishes, figures strongly in this chart. There are so many types of fish - goldfish, tropical fish, deep sea fish, fresh-water fish and so on. And the Pisces

person has so many facets to their personality that they are often called "dual". Generally, the true Piscean is gentle, peaceful, very sensitive, and truly compassionate. They are quiet and can seem withdrawn. They will often go off by themselves or to their bedrooms just for some peace and quiet. These kids will have a fantastic imagination, and that is where this little soul goes. They will burrow deep into the imagination where everything is beautiful, mystical, and serene. But these kids can also go where there are monsters and where the distortion of evil overwhelms them. So, the imagination is fine, taking time out is healthy, but escapism can be dangerous ground for this child.

Charlotte absorbs everything through the senses picking up bad vibes in an instant. These children feel any hostility as soon as they walk into a room - they don't need words. The Pisces person is always very sympathetic and will always listen to any tale of woe. Others will trust this sincerity and caring. Charlotte will be very adaptable but will dislike confrontation of any kind. This child will defend any friend who is in trouble but walk away from personal issues of hurt and disappointment. These kids can have a lot of difficulty making a decision. They will be easily distracted. This child will also hate to hurt anyone or say "no", so these kids can be quite easily led. This little child will be very sentimental, so they will count down their birthday each year and will be good at remembering everyone else's special day too.

Pisces is the most psychic sign of the zodiac but these "gifts" can be confusing for the young child. Charlotte will doubt the sensitivity and "go bush" rather than discuss what is happening. As they get older, this could well be a valuable tool to use. This little one will also have powerful dreams so will need to be able to talk about the scary ones. Charlotte will need the assurance that it was "just a dream".

Leo Dominant (Strength: 125.29)

One of the strongest signs in this Chart is Leo. This is the regal sign. This is Leo, the King of the jungle. Charlotte will have an optimistic attitude. This child will seem quite fearless and will like to be in command. These kids are outgoing, they love to have fun, and they love other people to have fun too. Charlotte will like to act, to perform, and to entertain. These children are very social. They love to have center stage. They like to be noticed. And they need to be liked and respected.

This personality can seem to be quite bossy and dictatorial. But like their jungle friends a lot of this is bravado. If the Leo character is cornered, or put in a position where they feel threatened, they will probably roar or give a royal sniff and make a very majestic exit. They will feel mortally wounded. Their pride will be in shreds, but they will go off to a very private place to lick their wounds. No one will know how deep those wounds have gone. The proud Leo will not allow that sign of weakness to show. So, in effect, Charlotte will not accept defeat well at all, and will not let the defenses slip in a noticeable way either. These kids are too proud for that, but deep down, that bold

exterior evaporates and so does the confidence. Fortunately, these sunny-natured kids seldom hold a grudge. They are too social for that and they enjoy life too much to be angry or bitter for long.

These children are not very good on their own for prolonged periods. Later in life, as adults, they can have a very special way with children. The Leo spirit will always be young at heart.

Sagittarius Dominant (Strength: 103.38)

One of the stronger signs in this Chart is Sagittarius, the Archer or the Centaur. This child will develop both physical and mental strength and also, stamina. Charlotte will always love to learn. These kids can make excellent teachers later because they like to share their knowledge and their expressive ways make them entertaining and easy to listen to. These kids can improve on the truth to add a bit more flavor to an experience or a story they are telling. This is not done in a menacing way - Charlotte will simply love to tell a good tale. Often a strong Sagittarius influence shows strongly in sports teams. Charlotte will be competitive, well coordinated, and will have the ability to encourage and drive team efforts. The attitude is also very fair.

These kids are capable of quite profound thinking and will develop a strong philosophy as they grow up. Interests lean towards the more universal subjects. The "big issues" will fascinate Charlotte. Often the thinking goes way beyond "global".

Charlotte will probably love the outdoors, the wide-open spaces, and will be fond of all creatures great and small. Even as youngsters, these kids will really enjoy school camps or even family camping holidays where they can get in touch with nature. They relish the beauty of the planet, Earth, and the elusive wonders of the beyond. These kids can wear themselves out though as they will never admit that they are tired. They want to be on the go the whole time. There is just so much for them to see and do. These are generally very happy and contented kids; they see the best in everything. They are not usually petty and their optimism gives them a good outlook which is contagious. These kids are able to lift the low spirits of those around them, and if they cannot, they will move on. Charlotte will avoid moody people who try to dampen the atmosphere in any way.

This is the sign of the "traveler", and these children will be interested in different countries and different cultures. Charlotte will probably be keen to buy a backpack as soon as possible and head off the see the world. It will be to experience the world and its people rather than as the average tourist.

DOMINANT HOUSE(S)

The Houses in the Natal Chart are very significant because they indicate the areas where we have been born lucky or where we have serious work to do. The Houses define the areas in life where we expend our energies, where we find recurring issues with which we have to deal.

The basic Natal Chart is simply the blueprint of the Heavens at the exact time of our birth. But in reading a child's chart, there is a different emphasis. Obviously a child "reflects" its everyday environment during the formative years and this Natal chart for Charlotte acknowledges these reflections. In the case of a child, many of the attitudes and habits are reflections of the up bringing and environmental influences. Often work needs to be done to reach out for the opposite House to achieve a fuller picture.

It is very important to apply these interpretations with the dominant sign and the planets involved. Together, they make much more sense and will be more easily recognized.

The report gives a "one-liner" explanation for each relevant House throughout the basic Chart, which relates to children.

Fourth House Dominant (Strength: 101.93)

4th House: The early home environment. The Mother influence. Early development.

Charlotte has a very strong 4th House influence. The 4th House is the early environment and the teachings within the home. It pertains quite strongly to the maternal influence. The 4th House is also indicative of new beginnings. Charlotte will be strongly attached to the Mother figure, who will have a powerful influence in the way this child thinks and behaves, providing the yardstick that this child will use to run its own life later. A few psychological tensions can be present. There is a real need for emotional security even within a relatively secure family atmosphere. These kids will tend to suffer quite badly from low self-esteem and will seem to be a lot more emotional than the rest of the family. It is likely that this child will burst into tears very easily and will be rather clingy and moody. But, they will make their feelings felt by throwing a sulk, or by storming off, rather than by throwing a tantrum. Consequently, they often do not clear the air. They will let their hurts linger for far too long because they will never forget.

Generally, these kids will probably have a very good memory, which they can put to good use throughout life. Everything about the childhood will be carefully preserved and committed to this vast memory bank. These kids, more than any others, will have a deep and lasting attachment to their childhood and all the memories that go with it.

The 4th House is at the base or the foundation of the Chart so it is a powerful point in any chart. This little one will need to reach out to the opposite House, the 10th House to look beyond the home, in order to reach out beyond the parental influences. The 4th house dominant child can use what they have learned to become who they want to be in their own right. They need to learn to look outwardly and reach for the stars, rather than cling to the past forever.

Second House Dominant (Strength: 101.72)

2nd House: This House is about values and possessions. It is the "my things" attitude. It is where nourishment is needed to feel confident and secure. This House is about experiencing the sensual fundamentals in order to feel fulfilled and loved. This House puts a real value on tangible assets, and it is where real fears are born with respect to deprivation. It is also where we learn to provide for ourselves if we must. It is where we discover our "comfort zone".

The 2nd House is the "I wants" in the child, and we all know as parents that there are always plenty of those. Charlotte, with a strong showing in the second House, will have lots of wants and needs. There will seem to be an endless list of things that this child "simply must have". These kids will probably try to keep up with the Jones's from a very early age. They will also compete strongly for affection. Often there can be a rather selfish attitude because in order to feel good, these kids have to have plenty of things that they can call their own, and that includes a special love and bond from the parents. Often these kids feel that in sharing, they lose the lot, so they may have to be shown that sharing is a form of speculation and accumulation.

There is quite a fear of "change". Charlotte would like life to always stay the same. This little one will need to be guided into being less clingy and more independent. There is a need to learn that real security comes from within. It has little to do with possessions.

This is also the House of our hidden talents, so this, being such a "busy" area, could be very significant of gifts that need to be drawn out. Creativity, perhaps - music - or perhaps a garden plot of their very own, will add to the inner confidence and be a source of pride and pleasure.

A lesson for Charlotte with a powerful 2nd House would be to lean a little towards the opposite House, the 8th House in the Chart. Charlotte will need to learn that everything changes, and that is not the end of the world. There is a need to accept that every part of life needs air to grow and to thrive. These kids must widen their horizons and be more independent. Learn, look within for their sense of security, and let their confidence expand.

Fifth House Dominant (Strength: 70.36)

5th House: Playing. Games. Creativity. Hobbies. Social life. Children.

This child has a crowded 5th House. The 5th house is leisure, fun, and sporting activities. It is all about enthusiasm, creative energy, and self-expression - and later, love-affairs. This is the House of learning to share talents, where we learn to entertain.

Charlotte will be sunny, happy, and very friendly and will probably have loads of friends. The social group (we hope) of planets in this house will suggest that it is very important that this little one does have a chance to develop their creativity. They need to be encouraged to have confidence in any ability in order to let real talents emerge. They need to be encouraged to be themselves and not become what they think is expected of them.

As they go through life, Charlotte will always be young at heart. But there will be a burning ambition to leave something of worth behind in this life. The aim will be to leave something for posterity. This child will feel robbed if they never have the chance to use their highly creative mind to its fullest ability. Probably, the "child" will always be alive and well in this person even when they venture into their adult years. This gives a real knack with children throughout life too. Charlotte will be able to communicate in such a way that is not patronizing or condescending. These kids can do a lot of good "looking after" younger people. Charlotte will enjoy smaller children and "littlies" will just love Charlotte.

Help to guide this little one into reaching out to the opposite house, the 11th House, to learn how to work as part of a group. It will be good for Charlotte to learn to be less subjective and less passionate, to learn to get involved in a "sharing" capacity, rather than allowing the ego to rule.

Balance of Elements and Modalities

DOMINANT ELEMENT(S)

The four elements figure strongly in the definition and interpretation of the signs. The dominant element(s) can help to identify the personality type quite successfully. In many cases, there will be a combination of more than one, which indicates more flexibility.

It can be quite easy to spot the "fiery" personality, the "down to earth" type, the "head in the clouds" Air person, or the weepy and emotional water character.

Abundant Water

The water signs are Cancer, Scorpio, and Pisces. Water indicates sensitivity, compassion, and imagination. These kids can be very deep and private. They can seem to be quite shy. A dominant moon, Neptune, or Pluto can add to the abundance of water characteristics in this chart.

These children are the most sensitive and emotional of all. They often feel not only their own emotions but also those of the people around them. When a water person meets someone for the first time, they can often size up the depths very quickly and accurately through sheer intuition. It is very important that the parents handle this ability carefully. They will need to be wary about who these children associate with. These kids can pick up negative and bad vibes as easily as they can pick up good vibes. And when they do hone into negative vibrations, they will take the whole lot on board themselves. "Other peoples problems" will become part of this sensitive child. For this same reason, it is not necessary to reprimand water children harshly. They get the picture with very few words and will "feel" the rest. In fact, it is less important to reprimand water children when they have done wrong than it is to reassure them afterward. It is vital that a water child has a secure childhood. The emotional impressions from childhood do not fade. There can be a danger that these kids can head for escapism too readily, to get away from the "nasties" that they do not want to face. They do not enjoy confrontation and will choose to retreat. Emotions may dominate this child's thinking so much that it is hard to reason with them.

If water children are brought up to feel secure within, they can be quite strong. Their sensitivity allows them to understand and give generously to those in need. With such a powerful imagination, they can be extremely artistic or creative. The sense of vision can be a powerful asset.

Abundant Fire

The Fire signs are Aries, Leo, and Sagittarius. Fire is all about impatience, enthusiasm, and energy. These kids will want to be involved in everything possible - and well as "impossible", at times. There will be a passion for life. A dominant Sun, Mars, or Jupiter will add to the predominance of fire characteristics in this chart.

These children are high-spirited, energetic and impulsive. They can have very quick tempers. They can be domineering and can be argumentative, but will not usually hold a grudge unless there is a good and valid reason. Fire signs are a little like a tropical storm, - a cloudburst, and then glorious sunshine. And then these volatile youngsters will genuinely wonder why everyone around them can be left quite wounded.

Charlotte will be independent, self-willed and self-motivated. This child can be a handful and will certainly need some discipline, but this needs to be administered carefully. After a heavily emotional confrontation with a fire child, the best time to discuss the situation is when the energies have cooled down (parents have to be saints at times). Charlotte will no doubt argue, but if the timing is right, will take any reprimands on board - but - do not expect any admission of being wrong. This kid will never go that far.

If any authority figure cracks the whip and overwhelms this child with no explanation, they will simply react even stronger and louder. The fire will intensify. If Charlotte gets the feeling that adults always use power arbitrarily, without rules or accountability, it will make Charlotte a fighter against the authorities.

Charlotte will be open and forthright, preferring to act out in front where the world can see. If you encourage honesty you will get just that. It may be coupled with a brutal frankness and a seeming insensitivity, but this would seldom be intended. These kids just do not stop to think.

Charlotte could find it difficult to cry or show emotions because it will be difficult to admit that something is wrong. The aim will always be to appear so strong and independent. It is very important that these children do learn to expose their feelings more. But remember - the aim with the predominantly Fire child is to tame them - not to break the valuable spirit.

Lack of Earth

When an element is "lacking", it can indicate a need to encourage the essentials of this "lack", to help round the character off a little. This often happens over time anyway, quite naturally. But watch Charlotte and you will see if any building needs to be done. But rather than see this as a "weakness", it is preferable to accept that one or more of the other elements comes through more strongly. The apparent "lack" can also be compensated within the chart anyway. It only needs one powerful aspect to add some weight.

The Earth signs are Taurus, Virgo, and Capricorn.

A lack of the Earth element in this chart suggests that this child may have some difficulties dealing with practical and mundane issues. In fact, it may be said that they are not really at home on the planet Earth. Charlotte may seem to be somehow lost in space and unable to get the feet on the ground. Because of this, these kids may reject responsibility. They can have trouble getting organized and following through on a task. Often there can be a childish inability to handle boring, but necessary tasks. Charlotte could be one of those kids who need help to accomplish the simplest chore. Material matters and money may be secondary concerns. These types may not be particularly interested in earthly possessions or any sort of material gain. Sometimes expressing a

compulsive trait toward neatness and detail compensates for the absence of the Earth element. Or, perhaps the compensation comes through as a major concern for organization.

More often, the absence of earth signs means good old-fashioned common sense may not be a strong suit. Charlotte should be encouraged to spend time outdoors with nature, to get in touch with the basic practicalities of life, and to learn to be more accountable and to take responsibility.

Lack of Air

When an element is "lacking", it can indicate a need to encourage the essentials of this "lack", to help round the character off a little. This often happens over time anyway, quite naturally. But watch Charlotte and you will see if any building needs to be done. But rather than see this as a "weakness", it is preferable to accept that one or more of the other elements comes through more strongly. The apparent "lack" can also be compensated within the chart anyway. It only needs one powerful aspect to add some weight.

The Air signs are Gemini, Libra, and Aquarius.

With the Air element lacking in this chart for Charlotte, it can mean an inability to think clearly or reasonably. There can be a real difficulty accepting the challenge of alternative views. This child can seem to be a bit of a void in some strange way. It is not that these kids are not intelligent, but just that they do not seem to place a lot of value on ideas and education for education's sake. Often, a shortage of Air signifies an inability to communicate effectively or clearly. Charlotte may work hard at being somewhat enigmatic and obscure. Sometimes there is self-consciousness. These kids may over-compensate by working hard to improve the personality because they realize that they have a problem in relating well. It may be hard for Charlotte to stand back and clearly view an issue in an objective manner - so there can be a tendency to have some trouble in the task of planning.

These people must make a special effort to communicate clearly and plan very carefully. Otherwise, any advancement will come only through costly trial and error.

DOMINANT MODES or QUALITIES

The "Modes" or the "Qualities" often indicate how we initiate our actions. The Cardinal types are firm, confident, and are better starters than they are finishers. The Fixed types are quite reluctant to step outside of the comfort zone. They prefer to stay with the tried and true. The Mutable people are flexible and adaptable but they can be flimsy.

But, again, in many cases there is a combination of more than one mode.

Abundant Mutable

The mutable signs are Gemini, Virgo, Sagittarius, and Pisces. These are the signs of change, and the essential mark is adaptability.

Charlotte will either try to find a way around a problem or will give way in the face of the attack. This quality of mutability is not a weakness, because although these kids do bend like a reed in the wind, they do manage to survive and persist. Charlotte will believe in flowing with the energies of the surrounding environment. These kids can adapt to the characteristics of the current company. Nevertheless, these children have a core of inner truth that enables them to make quite a subtle impact on those around them. By appearing to give way, these kids can sometimes be quite manipulative.

The mutable signs except Virgo are known as dual or two-bodied signs (meaning that they have two distinct sides). This reflects the mutable person's ability to have more than one facet. Charlotte will actually thrive in unstable and changing circumstances. These kids are able to grab what they need and adapt very quickly to new conditions. In fact, often boredom will set in if the situation is not constantly changing. With all of this adaptability, however, Charlotte can be rather devious at times. It is hard to pin these types down to a definite course of action or a commitment. They feel that such commitment limits the freedom. Not being forthright can be a major problem, except possibly with Sagittarius.

Given any kind of resistance at all, these kids simply change direction and take the line of least resistance, even if inappropriate.

Lack of Cardinal

The Cardinal Modes are made up of the signs Aries, Cancer, Libra, & Capricorn.

A deficiency of cardinality in a chart leads to certain problems like a difficulty in getting started on projects. Once started, however, these kids are able to keep on moving. Often persons who are deficient in cardinality will wait for others to start something before getting involved. They do not like to be accountable or take the responsibility. However, this does not mean that Charlotte will be more passive necessarily, simply not particularly aggressive or dogmatic. A strong emphasis on Mars or the Sun in the chart will go a long way to make up for a lack of cardinal signs.

FINALE

As adults, we look back on our youth and say, "if only I knew then what I know now". How many of us also, as we get older, "discover" a talent that has never been recognized and say "if only". If this Chart report simply indicates a talent that can be nurtured early in life, as opposed to laying dormant for too long a time, or forever, then the author's objective has been reached.
