## Introduction

This report from Halloran Software, In The Beginning, draws upon 1529 paragraphs which interpret the places of the planets at the time of your birth, describing your personal houses, sign placements, and planetary aspects.

These astrological delineations depict your potential and how to make the most of it, or the challenges you will continue to face and how to confront and benefit from them. Though you may change through experience, your inherent characteristics will still motivate how you act and react to circumstances. How you handle yourself is really a clue to your success, and it is up to you to make the "right" choices.

Here are the parts which make up your chart:

HOUSES: Govern sections of your life, e.g., your money, your health, your partners, etc. They are also meaningful as to where your early interests lie and if they are worth pursuing.

SIGNS: Contribute feelings or vibrations to "color" planets, e.g., MERCURY rules GEMINI and VIRGO and emphasizes their qualities of thought, travel, health, and work. JUPITER rules SAGITTARIUS and higher education, spiritual growth, and law.

ASPECTS: Are angles combining the planets in the SIGNS/HOUSES that trigger the manner in which you will be influenced or can handle your qualities to advantage, e.g., MERCURY (thought) TRINE (in good aspect to) JUPITER (education and law) may indicate that you can succeed as a counselor in legal matters.

A "Strength" number precedes each ASPECT interpretation towards the end of the reading. This number synthesizes how exact is the aspect, whether the aspect is major or minor, and whether an aspecting planet is close to one of the four chart angles. The higher the Strength, the more you are likely to feel the aspect and to live it out in your life.

You are most likely to feel and act out the report's sign and house placement interpretations when the planets involved are strong in your chart. This is true especially of the outer planets, Jupiter through Pluto. AstrolDeluxe has a Planet Strengths graph that calculates the respective power and harmony of all the planets in your chart.

# **Planets in Signs and Houses**



## **Cancer Ascendant**

(The Emotional)

You may have either a smoothly-round face or furrowed brows, which give you a "pinched" look, but one thing is unmistakable: Your moods! One moment you're all sunshine, and the next, hiding behind mysterious clouds. Perhaps you expect others to know what is "wrong", but not everyone has your insightful gifts. If you sulk too often or too long, you may lose your friends. Try putting the feelings of others first. You may even enjoy the respect it can earn you.



# Sun in Cancer

(Keynote: I FEEL)

You are sensitive, nurturing, devoted and caring, but can be moody, petulant, over-emotional and unforgiving. Your attachment to the home stems from an allegiance to a mother-figure. Your interest in food may extend to gourmet cooking as a hobby or a career. You are an excellent business person, with a shrewd and logical view, but tend to keep things to yourself, which is not always wise. If you have no outlet for your feelings, you may make yourself the victim of digestive ills, or prolonged seclusion may cost you the friendship of those who represent security in your life.

## Sun in the Twelfth House

(The Recluse)

Some view this placement as the result of a misuse of power in past lives, because you are unduly hard on yourself. Your over-active mind is impressionable. You may become a square peg in a round hole if you wear the mask of others as your own. You require periods of seclusion for rest and self-examination, because you question why "no-one" understands you. If you seek counseling, you may become a counselor to help others avoid the pain of your experiences. You, too, are deserving. Acknowledge that if you are your own worst enemy, you can be your own best friend.



# Moon in Virgo

(The Spartan)

Your outwardly-cool attitude may cause others to approach you with caution, and make friendship difficult. You are capable of accomplishing a lot, with little to work with. You are not particularly ambitious, but may over-emphasize your limitations. A place in scientific research is possible, where your practical mind and attention to detail can be appreciated. If you are too hard on yourself or others, you can destroy your chances for recognition of your excellent merits. Digestive difficulties may occur if you fret obsessively with no outlet for your frustrations.

# Moon in the Second House

### (The Collector)

You may take some time to settle into a job. Bank a portion of your paycheck -- even ask someone to manage your money for you. Otherwise you may become a compulsive spender, gathering possessions which may substitute for emotional needs. Going it alone, you may identify too closely with your possessions. In choosing a partner, it should be a person who is appreciative of your spiritual, as well as material growth and is willing to contribute and grow with you.

## (The Parent)

Your remarkable intuition lets you see the vulnerability of your fellow man, but it may be somewhat narrow in concept. Whether formally-educated or not, you have a wealth of knowledge to share and a way of expressing yourself that is entirely captivating. One can almost forgive you for being a "world-class flirt!"

### Venus in the Twelfth House

#### (The Helpmate)

You may be drawn into affairs that must be kept secret. You will put yourself second as you support loved ones, but may feel your love is unrequited. You may take the burden of blame upon yourself if things go wrong and find yourself like the poet who remonstrated: "Nevermore." The agony of a lost love was so eloquent that he could not bear to voice it, but had it spoken by a Raven. Sometimes, a head ruling a broken heart can soften sorrows caused by the reverse.

#### Mars in Aquarius

# (The Forerunner)

You focus on the future and see things with amazing clarity, so are apt to be impatient with those who do not have your vision. Your motives are the best -- to do for others what they cannot do for themselves. You are a matchless fund-raiser and know who to approach and what to say to accomplish your missions. You extend this nurturing quality in your personal life. All who recognize your kindness are sure to return the interest and appreciation you deserve.

#### Mars in the Eighth House

#### (The Broker)

An inner knowledge fits you to deal with people on the most basic of levels. Through human encounter, you will continually change your life patterns, if not your goals. Others will trust you to handle their ideas, personal conflicts and their money. It is up to you to find ways to encourage the expansion of your associates and their assets in an objective manner without forcing an egoistic view of your personal evolution upon them.

#### **Jupiter in Scorpio**

### (The Investor)

You may manage other people's time and money successfully. Your keen intuition and bent for speculation can help you create your own dynasty. You're apt to over-do or become self-indulgent. Make "moderation" your watchword to avoid unfortunate side-effects which can impair your health and rob you of the rewards of the charmed life you lead.

### Jupiter in the Fifth House

### (The Sensualist)

Your feelings are deep and significant and are always a reflection of who you truly are. You express yourself eloquently, like an artist, who works in larger-than-life strokes. You experience true love as a spiritual transformation. Like Michelangelo, you find angels in the stone by bringing out the best in the people you meet.

### Saturn in Gemini

### (The Vassal)

Responsibilities of loved ones can limit your outstanding ability to express yourself. You may adopt a life of fantasy to escape becoming hard or bitter. Many writers epitomize your frustrations: Beatrix Potter, Ralph Waldo Emerson and the Bronte Sisters among them. They were visionaries who overcame "self" to share a corner of their indomitable spirits. Your lack of freedom is far less meaningful than the opportunity for self-discipline you will learn to value.

### Saturn in the Eleventh House

### (The Fund-raiser)

You are essentially a loner and don't adapt easily to performing as part of a unit unless you are in the driver's seat. You are likely to hold a responsible office in any group you join and will perform your duties flawlessly, particularly those of treasurer or of handling details to boost organizational funds. Once your peers are convinced of your merits, you should have no trouble taking your place as a valued member of any society.

### **Uranus in Libra**

### (The Bohemian)

You have artistic talent and appreciate modern, as well as traditional forms. You are intelligent, ambitious and determined, but may change your goals too often. ## **Uranus in the Third House**

### (The Chameleon)

You are like an explorer, never denying that anything is possible and delighted to discover the unusual. You may lack a basic security, but get the most out of staying flexible--a perpetual student, open to new experiences as part of your development, that keep you young at heart.

#### Neptune in Sagittarius

(The Sage)

You have a talent for understanding human nature and an uncanny ability to know what makes people "tick." You are a perpetual student, and a gifted teacher. Your thirst for knowledge will prompt you to travel extensively. Try to remember that you must accept the customs of another country before they will accept you. Your beliefs are unconventional. You will continue to learn by experience and teach in love as did Plato, Socrates and their descendants in spirit.

### Neptune in the Fifth House

#### (The Romantic)

You tend to put people on pedestals, and expect more of them than they can deliver. Your life is a soap-opera of your own creation from childhood, full of smiles and pathos. If you could bottle or sell your dreams, or find a practical use for them, such as projecting them into a theatrical project, the world that "always loves a lover" would welcome your refreshing views. Otherwise, you may face perpetual disappointment by refusing to accept reality.

### **Pluto in Virgo**

### (The Restorers)

You have a rare opportunity of renovating the world in carefully-structured channels when the environment seems at its lowest ebb. Drugs, disease, addictions and crime will no longer be tolerated. You will have a major part in seeing that justice is done. Law-makers, and those who execute the law will be among your peers, as well as some who are willing to educate those who truly desire self-improvement as their contribution to elevate mankind.

### Pluto in the Third House

### (The Dominator)

You regard life seriously, questioning yourself and others at every turn and disdaining the frailty of human existence. Frivolity seems without value and your uncommon powers of concentration make you impervious to pleasurable distraction. You may impose your will on co-workers and relatives; then criticize their inability to cope. If you are inflexible, you may build a wall that prevents sharing your life and become a prisoner of your own design.

## **Aries Midheaven**

You will achieve your greatest success in life through competition, self-assertion, and your ability to start new activities. Not one to sit on the sidelines, your career shows your need for pioneering activities, combat, challenge, and accomplishment. You are a strong individual who can carry more than your share of the load. You are self-directed and prefer to work independently.

You can throw fresh light on your chosen career field because you are so honest and direct. Less adventuresome souls benefit from and continue the projects that you start. One drawback of this placement is that (unless Virgo is rising) you find it difficult to perform routine tasks for long, especially if doing so does not bring the affection or praise that you desire. If you are not mature, you may surprise others by resorting to brute force to get your own way. Action for its own sake will exhaust you and lead nowhere. When you are indecisive, actively search out the truth.

Occupations consistent with your active, leading style of work include director, instructor, superintendent, manager, inventor, pioneering writer, entrepreneur, athlete, dancer, actor, laborer, driver, policeman, security guard, or the military. For the most personal career guide, also consider the nature of any planets which fall in the 10th house or conjoin the Midheaven, the sign and house placements of Mars, ruler of the Midheaven, and any aspects which other planets make to the Midheaven.

### North Node in Aquarius

# (The Arrogant)

You demand center stage, but are disappointed if there is little applause for your flamboyant performance. As a member of the audience, you must cheer others for their efforts. With a dual perspective, you may realize that you are part of a larger design, devoid of ego or self-aggrandizement. Release your humanitarian instincts to enjoy the Big Show.

# North Node in the Seventh House

### (The Hero)

You may win every battle, and demand credit for all you do, but without admiration, your victories are hollow. You are essentially self-sufficient, but to achieve happiness must learn to share your fortunes, no matter what they have cost you. In sharing with those who are weaker in talent, effort and resolve, you will receive the honors you desire.

### **Chiron in Aries**

Chiron is a minor planet that orbits in between Saturn and Uranus. In the astrology chart, Chiron serves as a bridge between normal consciousness and higher consciousness. Chiron can bring limitations, but it is also connected with finding ways to overcome limitations, to heal and to grow. Chiron spends an average of four years in any one sign, so everyone born in the same years will have the same sign placement. Chiron's sign placement is most likely to influence your life if Chiron has many aspects or is near one of the four angles in your chart.

You may start life unsure of who you are, wondering about your identity, but you can be anything that you want to be. You have a low-key but competitive personality that will carry you far. You recognize that, while you have to be natural, you also have to be different. The result is that you have a distinct and precise style. You have a trick of getting the maximum of attention with a minimum of fuss. You are a hard worker, but you follow your own path and tend not to observe old-fashioned rules. If your initial career efforts do not pay off, you will adapt and try something else. A strong Chiron with favorable aspects makes it likely that you will be athletic and competitive. With inharmonious aspects, you could be a reformer. You could identify a career in your teen years, only to be blocked from immediately pursuing it. A health-related matter could boost your career. More than most people, you learn the possible ways that you can be from the different mentors and partners whom you attract. You, in turn, are willing to help mentor and teach others.

# **Chiron in the Ninth House**

You find inspiration through travel and contacts with different cultures. This placement makes you like an ambassador between cultures or between different fields of knowledge. It enables your mind to function at a higher level. It helps you to see the bigger picture. You are playful and love games and sports. Your playful attitude is what enables you to venture into new areas. You do not let yourself be mentally blocked from trying new things. Your exploratory behavior enables you to be a guide for everyone else.

# **Planets in Aspect**

### Mercury conjunct Ascendant (Strength: 10.21)

Family trauma tends to be frequent with this aspect. Your interests might be less masculine when it comes to play and sports. Many healers have this aspect. It could be easier for you to live a religious and celibate lifestyle. You are more likely to have spiritual experiences. However, this aspect is frequently positive when it comes to fathering several children. You have a facility with language that makes the occupations of diplomat, public speaker, law enforcement officer, lawyer, poet, teacher, politician, comedian, pastor, and coach more frequent. There may also be cooking ability, mechanical ability, or general manual dexterity. You could do well at playing an instrument, writing songs, or composing music. The downside of this aspect is that you could jump from topic to topic with only superficial understanding. Few designers, mathematicians, or psychologists have this aspect. You are not particularly steadfast or courageous. Few pilots, fighters, or champion athletes have this aspect. You tend to move from job to job. Your willingness to change has the positive consequence that you are unlikely to suffer from depression. Men with this aspect are more likely to build wealth.

### Mercury square Chiron (Strength: 9.83)

This aspect makes you more likely to have been born into a large family. This is an aspect of discipline, creativity, and honesty. You are more likely to have spiritual or psychic experiences. You can have a youthful appearance, especially if you avoid cigarettes. Frequent vocations include award-winning actor, doctor, visual artist, physicist, poet, singer, director, dancer, fighter, champion athlete, scientist, and engineer. The actor Kurt Russell was born with this aspect exact within 1 minute. The champion athlete Hank Aaron had this aspect exact within 4 minutes. You are more likely to have four or more children, although there could be some difficulty involving you and children. An injury or illness could cause a career change. You could enjoy a sudden change, such as winning the lottery. Your mate could endeavor to educate you. Letters and correspondence could somehow be challenging. You could make yourself sick trying to bring reason to the unreasonable, trying to increase the consciousness of the bigoted and the prejudiced. Be careful that in your drive into the future you do not put yourself above ordinary rules of moral conduct. You could be known for your wit and speaking ability.

### Ascendant square Chiron (Strength: 8.59)

You faced serious challenges in your youth which you had to overcome and which motivated you to grow. These challenges increased your consciousness and awareness. You could be interested in conservation and the environment. You are informed and in charge.

## Sun sesquiquadrate Mars (Strength: 7.97)

This aspect does not protect you from family traumas. You appear to be active, charming, and easy-going. You get along well with other guys as part of a team. You can be an explorer, adventurer, and researcher. You are looking for sources of power. When you hit upon something that works, you will decisively exploit it for all that it is worth. You love your work and you give it your all. You might keep the goodies for yourself and away from competitors. You must be a risk-taker, because the two most frequent categories for this aspect are Wealthy and Prison, one or the other. Of all the 5800 charts in our Famous collection, Elon Musk has this aspect the closest, exact within 1 minute. This aspect can confer the masculine power to execute goals that are determined by the rest of your chart. In private, you can be lazy, irresponsible, cunning, and cruel, which my wife says is true of all men, just to different degrees. Being a successful man comes with a lot of expectations, which you can resent. You might start abusing alcohol. Sometimes you surprise your family by just taking off or deciding to do something without consulting them. Discipline is not this aspect's strong point. You are not particularly steadfast. It is not important to you to be a perfectionist. You are not the type who keeps working at the same job for a long time. This aspect can make you a professional fighter, and it can also make you a poet. Spiritual experiences are possible. Many vegetarians have this aspect, perhaps because you have sympathy for the powerless. That same caring nature can make you a law enforcement officer or a cook. Many broadcasters have had this aspect. Elon was a regular broadcaster on Twitter before he bought it, and renamed it X.

### Saturn opposite Neptune (Strength: 7.42)

Many researchers have this aspect. Complex details agree with you. You hunger for knowledge. You tend to be disciplined, creative, adventurous, enthusiastic, critical, steadfast, brave, and honest. Your creative side could result in poetic or musical composition. You could rise from poverty to wealth. You could be a vegetarian and/or an animal lover. You could come from a large family and might have a religious calling. The sportsmanship and camaraderie of athletics or dance can appeal to you. The state of marriage seems to agree with you. You could raise several children. It is hard to say whether the socially conservative influence of Saturn or the progressive influence of Neptune will be stronger in your life. If it will help your community, you can work as a law enforcement professional or, alternately, you could become a pastor, pioneer, or activist. If your life goes down the wrong path, do not be surprised if you experience bodily symptoms from depression.

### Pluto contraparallel North Node (Strength: 5.36)

This is an aspect of intelligence. It appears to increase your attention-seeking behavior. One man had a job as a singing messenger. This is not the aspect of a tough-guy fighter. This is not the aspect of someone who takes a particular stand. You feel pressure from the group. You can

become a crime victim. You have the ability to enlist many people to be your fans and supporters. There is an element of shared group loyalty. You identify with a particular group, which rewards you with its loyalty. You can maintain a consistent signature look and appearance. You tend to have a distinct style. You appeal to a particular group. This Pluto aspect makes you capable of range, depth, and intensity. Vocations that occur frequently with this aspect include psychologist, pilot, lawyer, astrologer, businessman, computer expert, actor, scientist, and marketer. Chances are that you will have several children and live a long life.

# Mars parallel Jupiter (Strength: 5.34)

With this aspect, your forte is spontaneous, improvisational action. You act in the moment, sometimes without knowing what you are doing. You react to opportunity. You can creatively navigate in a chaotic environment. You are more impulsive than reflective. You take risks. Following the rules is not who you are. You can challenge oppressive authority. You have a drive to expand - it causes you to continually test the limits of what you can get away with. You do not avoid confrontation. Statistically, this aspect does not avoid alcohol or drugs. You could have a high-spending lifestyle. You will probably stay mentally alert to the end. The top vocations for this aspect are chef, comedian, scientist, psychic, explorer, singer, poet, and award-winning actor.

# Jupiter parallel Neptune (Strength: 5.19)

This aspect gives you strength. It shows a strong statistical correlation with champion athletes, fighters, and having four or more children. It is prevalent in the charts of men who are disciplined and who work as coaches or engineers. You are likely to be intelligent and efficient. You have the stamina to be a singer, politician, or pilot. You can be good at navigating in the real world. You combine wide-ranging research with a fertile imagination. Your bliss can involve bringing more elegance and beauty into this world, via your creations. With this aspect, you are flexible and good at seizing opportunity when it knocks on your door. There are a lot of ideas brewing in your head. You are not looking to conquer the world, however. Your priority is more to have a sane and balanced life. You tend to be considerate of other people's needs, so that people feel safe with you. You are likely to be a protective parent. You could end up customizing your house with innovative features. A liquor bar could be the focal point of your house. You might be able to handle your liquor better than your spouse, which could affect your marriage. Divorce is common for both men and women with this aspect. You can be inventive, but your focus tends to be on people more than technology. You could take an interest in politics.

### Saturn contraparallel Neptune (Strength: 4.79)

You may have seen things differently from your father. With this aspect, you can work for law enforcement, but you could also feel that you know more than the authorities, and you might be right. Many physicists and religious leaders have this aspect, indicating a desire to peer behind the veil, to get a deeper understanding of the world. You could leave home at a young age. The kind of life that seems to work the best with this aspect is a life of public service. You can see a need and try to fill it. You reach out to others. Many poets, artists, explorers, pioneers, researchers, psychologists, scientists, doctors, lawyers, and diplomats have this aspect. You can make use of mass media, social media, and photography. You combine perfectionism with enthusiasm. You believe in social justice. You have a particular social vision and could join or found a movement or society. If you cannot find a constructive way by which you can work with others to make the world a better place, there is a danger that you will turn to alcohol or drugs with this aspect. There are no guarantees, but this aspect tends to give a long life.

## Venus trine Mars (Strength: 4.50)

This aspect tends to give natural athletic and fighting ability. One of the greatest baseball players of all time, Willie Mays, was born with this aspect exact within 7 minutes. Possibly related to athletic ability, many pilots also have this aspect, including Archie Harris, who had it exact within 7 minutes and who was both a champion discus thrower and a WWII bomber pilot. Many physicists have this aspect, such as Giovanni Polvani with this aspect exact within 1 minute. One of the top vocations for this aspect is singer. Ray Charles, the popular blind musician, pianist, and singer, had this aspect exact within 1 minute. The opera singer Lauritz Melchior had it within 3 minutes. Examples of men who became wealthy include the Swedish entrepreneur and international financier Ivar Kreuger and the co-founder of Twitter and other Internet startups, Biz Stone, both of whom show this aspect exact within 3 minutes. This aspect is likely to stay at the same job but not necessarily the same marriage. The divorce rate is high. With this aspect, you tend to go with the flow.

# Mars parallel Neptune (Strength: 4.46)

This lucky aspect marries courage and enthusiasm with curiosity and a creative vision. It makes you a keen observer. It might take some years of bouncing around before you discover where you can make a difference. You can end up at the forefront of contemporary culture. Trust yourself. Don't give in to social pressures to conform. Like a film director, you have a distinctive vision, which you have the ability to promote. You can get a thrill out of advancing human welfare. Activities purely for utilitarian or money-making purposes bore you. Challenges attract you. Your adventuresome spirit could make you an explorer, a fighter, or a law enforcement professional. A close circle of friends can come before career. You have empathy for your fellow man and tend to be blind to distinctions of race or class. You can be soft-spoken but intense. With this aspect, you can be an activist striving to make the world a more humane

place. With this aspect, stay away from alcohol and pain-killers because there is a danger of addiction. Frequent vocations include architect, psychologist, critic, doctor, chef, and marketing professional. You have a tendency towards careful perfectionism and discipline. You could also be a likable character actor, business man, or healing professional.

# Jupiter sextile Pluto (Strength: 4.38)

Jupiter and Pluto take each other to extremes. Although soft-spoken and businesslike in person, the native can become flamboyant and on the wild edge of human behavior. Normal limits do not seem to apply. This is a top aspect for having four or more children. The most common categories are drug abuser, professional fighter, radio/television broadcaster, prisoner, murderer, psychic, psychologist, award-winning actor, adventurer, engineer/mechanic, and criminal. It makes sense that a world-class poker player has this aspect because men with this aspect take big gambles that sometimes make them masters in their field. Many men with this aspect in their biographies study law but then use it as a springboard to something else. You can become impatient and look for new methods that will provide dramatic shortcuts. This aspect is part of the universe's plan, which does not always involve following the rules.

# Sun square BlackMoon (Strength: 4.28)

Boys with this aspect tend to be shielded against experiencing family trauma. This aspect gives you a quivering intensity and plenty of energy. You enjoy attention. You do have to work for your success - it may not come right away - but you have both the drive and the ability. You are relatively fearless, taking a lot of chances. You probably move fast and talk fast. It is remarkable the high frequency of this aspect in the large collections of male athletes and military enlistees. This aspect is also frequent in the charts of engineers, drug abusers, chefs, public speakers, suicide cases, medical doctors, and mathematicians. The French engineer and parapsychologist Marie George Chevalier, who had this aspect exact within 2 minutes, served as an Army officer in both WW I and WW II and authored books about death, parapsychology, and miracles. Robert Esnault-Pelterie, who had this aspect exact within 8 minutes, was a pioneering aircraft designer and spaceflight theorist. Richard Edmund Lyng, who had this aspect exact to the minute, served in the Army in WW II and then ran the family agricultural business, becoming a knowledgeable, cordial, and well-liked executive in the industry who was appointed in 1986 as the U.S. Secretary of Agriculture.

# Saturn trine BlackMoon (Strength: 3.94)

You can be a consummate negotiator -- well-organized, fair and attentive to detail. You tend to be cautious and like to be the one in control. You have the mental ability to improvise on the spot. Many award-winning actors have this aspect. You could bring a nontraditional look. A director said of Dustin Hoffman with this aspect, "Everything involved his total attention and he is so meticulous that it is exhausting." Slender vegetarians are frequent.

You can be known for flaunting convention and authority. You are passionate, but you express it in a civilized and elegant way. This aspect ranks high for honesty and for working in law enforcement. You could also work as a doctor or as a chef. You are very unlikely to keep working at the same job for ten or more years. You burn through the years of your life quickly, which is not helped by this aspect's high rates for drug and alcohol abuse and suicide. You are cool, cerebral and idiosyncratic. You have real knowledge and could write informative books. You tend to conduct yourself like an aristocrat, such as dressing elegantly even when relaxing. You are likely to have socially influential friends and relatives.

## Jupiter contraparallel Saturn (Strength: 3.88)

This aspect tends to make you a long-lived contentious striver. You are a self-starter who can pursue his own education. You can be kind of a Renaissance man, fluent in many subjects. You tend to be a student of man and nature, which can include mathematics. You question everything. You are so committed to growth that you even challenge and question yourself. You have high expectations, for both yourself and those with whom you work. Your career can be marked with controversy. Protect yourself and your family as this aspect elevates the possibility of becoming a crime victim. You can develop strong opinions on social or political matters. Your confrontational nature could see you in court as a litigant or as an attorney. You lack discipline. You can get a reputation for being prickly and antagonistic. The most common occupations with this aspect include mathematician, doctor, champion athlete, the military, lawyer, and religious pastor. You can benefit from having a friend off whom to bounce your ideas. Many men with this aspect end up being married for fifteen or more years. The aspect is fortunate for wealth.

### Jupiter sesquiquadrate Ascendant (Strength: 3.81)

You could have grown up in a large family. This aspect seems to protect you against family trauma. You never stop educating yourself and growing. Spiritual experiences are possible. You could learn how to dance at a young age. You have social skills and can collaborate with others. You can contribute to society. You are more likely to start a group or association. Frequent vocations include marketing, public speaking, physician, diplomat, astrologer, politician, and chef. It is significant how many men with this aspect have fathered four or more children. You could have more than one marriage. It is also significant how many actors have this aspect, although few have won acting awards. You are intelligent and could work as an engineer, computer programmer, critic, architect, pilot, or teacher. This aspect seems to be more vulnerable to illness and crime, so work on protecting yourself.

# Sun square Uranus (Strength: 3.41)

This aspect does not make it likely that you will be the enthusiastic type, but it does make it more likely that you will become an aviator or pilot. You are driven to overcome obstacles and challenges. Only 5% of Boy Scouts earn the rank of Eagle Scout, but that could be you. You tend to be a thinker and a perfectionist. You could become a pastor, a politician, a writer, a

singer, or a computer programmer. Your life may seem to be about rising through the ranks. When you have the big picture, you can make reforms. You could enjoy radio, television, or computer work. You can be a pioneering inventor. This aspect is vulnerable to developing dementia, but the best antidote to dementia is to do what you love.

# Venus trine North Node (Strength: 3.12)

This aspect can make you an attractive, sociable person who enjoys the good life. Many champion athletes are born with this aspect. You tend to be creative, adventurous, and able to connect with the public. Many marketers have this aspect, such as Peter Bruckmann, who had this aspect exact within 7 minutes, and who marketed the products of many artists. A seven-time All-Star baseball player with a distinctive handlebar mustache, Rollie Fingers, had this aspect exact within 9 minutes. Fingers retired to become a salesman and then came out with a book that combines elements of baseball humor, anecdotal storytelling, odd lists and historical trivia. With this aspect, you might be savvy about computers and use them to maintain a political or activist network. Visual artists, coaches, politicians, public speakers, activists, vegetarians, and fighters frequently have this aspect. You tend to have a steadfast character. You are attracted to research, which might explain why so many with this aspect have discovered astrology. Together with your high creativity, your life is more likely to deal with the categories of psychic experience, dementia, and drug abuse. You are probably looking for experiences and growth more than you are security.

# Jupiter inconjunct Midheaven (Strength: 3.11)

This is an aspect of intelligence. Many writers, architects, scientists, public speakers, and researchers were born with this aspect. Being a singer, however, is not your thing. It is interesting that animal lover is the most frequent category, as animal circus performers such as Roy Horn and Gunther Gebel-Williams were born with this aspect. Gunther tried to understand the personality of each individual animal. Family trauma, alcohol abuse, and suicide can accompany this aspect, but as in the case of Roy Horn, you could find animals to be more loving companions than people. It says something about this aspect's mentality that healing is a frequent chart category, together with the categories of psychic, psychologist, spiritual experiences, astrologer, dementia, creative, and religious. What your personality has in brilliance, it lacks in discipline. If alcohol abuse is a problem, perhaps you depend upon that helper to dampen your awareness? Animals and astrology sound like better alternatives than abusing alcohol. This aspect gives you the ability to see beyond the superficialities of a person into their depths.

# Mercury sesquiquadrate Jupiter (Strength: 3.01)

As a child, you had a talent for mimicry. As an adult, you are able to express yourself in colorful and forceful ways. You tend to be an ambitious optimist. You dream and play in a big world and you are always willing to try one more venture. You are not a perfectionist, but personal honesty and integrity are strong. You are not afraid of strangers and will reach out over and over again until you find the backing that you need. This is not the aspect of an entrepreneur, but it is

the aspect of a diplomat, director, law enforcement officer, engineer, physicist, award-winning actor, musician, or religious leader. You are persistent when it comes to building up your knowledge of how things work. You will put in long hours. This aspect makes you steadfast. The top two statistical categories for this aspect are working at the same job for ten or more years and mental depression. You excel at organizing information. In whatever field you work, your thorough persistence accumulates to build you into a recognized and solid contributor. However, watch out that your success does not turn into arrogance and thinking that social rules do not apply to you.

# Uranus square Ascendant (Strength: 2.99)

You could come from an advantaged background, but possibly experience some family trauma. Uranus makes you intelligent but rebellious. You might end up in prison or find ways to change or challenge the system. This aspect gives you the energy to put in long hours. Many entrepreneurs have this aspect. You can work at the same job and/or stay married to the same woman for many years. Unfortunately, alcohol and drug abuse, depression, and suicide are common challenges. The most frequent category is steadfast, which means that you have the backbone to confront controversy and to stick to your principles. You might have a deadpan expression with a booming voice. You can put your energy into creating a book as a writer or building a house as an architect. You can master a computer or a musical instrument. Many pastors, lawyers, and politicians, as well as explorers and scientists, were born with this aspect.

# Jupiter conjunct Neptune (Strength: 2.83)

This aspect tends to make your life a combination of victories and losses. Consistent with this description, you could be a fighter, a doctor, or a competitive athlete. You could have a fun and lively nature that makes you stand out. You could have four or more children and are likely to have multiple marriages and divorces, possibly because you act on impulse. You tend to pay your dues by working in a dedicated manner at the same craft for many years. You tend to be honest and a perfectionist. Many pilots, music composers, engineers, television announcers, comedians, designers, scientists, activists, pioneers, coaches, and actors have this aspect.

# Moon semi-square East Point (Strength: 2.82)

Men with this aspect are more likely to have experienced some family trauma that caused them to grow up early. Spells of depression can be common. You make yourself busy in the world. The aspect gives you what I call a high burn rate, where you have high intelligence and a high activity level that makes you less likely to achieve a long life. You are likely to be intelligent, a perfectionist, steadfast, and creative. The actor, musician, and singer Tom Wopat, whose birthtime is known precisely and who has this aspect exact within 2 minutes, and who is said to be friendly, fun-loving and engaging, began singing and dancing in school musicals when he was 12 years old. Dancer is this aspect's most frequent category. Also frequent are television personalities, writers, fighters, architects, designers, musicians, diplomats, astrologers, lawyers, pilots, artists, actors, scientists, physicians, and military enlistees. You are least likely to become

a pastor. The conceptual designer and illustrator, Ralph McQuarrie, who was born with this aspect exact within 1 minute, was a highly creative artist whose work was foundational to the success of Star Wars. This aspect favors having a long marriage and several children.

# Jupiter trine East Point (Strength: 2.77)

This aspect does not confer a high level of control. This aspect does not make you a perfectionist. You are less likely to exert the effort needed to accomplish a goal, such as becoming a champion athlete. This aspect is more about trusting yourself to experience, flow, and learn. You are more likely to work as a musician, critic, engineer, pastor, singer, or public speaker. The critical repartee of a talk show could agree with you, where the writer, comedian, TV personality, voice actor, YouTube personality, music blogger and Twitter personality The Kid Mero has this aspect exact within 4 minutes, where his Jupiter and Uranus both trine the East Point. You are more likely to be creative and courageous. Loving animals and having spiritual experiences are frequent for this aspect. This aspect has higher rates of dementia. You have the mental toughness to be a medical doctor or a mathematician.

# Jupiter opposite Saturn (Strength: 2.54)

This is an aspect of the chivalrous and heroic male. You tend to be slender and tough. You are high in discipline and perfectionism. The high representation of this aspect within the large chart categories of the military, scientists, engineers, doctors, and pioneers is quite significant. The aspect is also over-represented among critics, researchers, animal lovers, poets, singers, diplomats, athletes, and coaches. You tend to be easy to like and socially aware. This opposition aspect gives you a personality that protects you against cancer, as it has only half the rate as the conjunction, and it gives longer than average life expectancy.

# Mercury sesquiquadrate Neptune (Strength: 2.41)

With this aspect, you tend to be the curious and honest type. You are in touch with your human feelings and you take them seriously. It is difficult for you to be callous or insensitive. You believe in human equality and you are opposed to people being treated as if they don't matter. You have the courage of your convictions and will actually walk your talk when it comes to fighting for the rights of the persecuted and ignored. Many fighters, law enforcement agents, public speakers, diplomats, and social activists were born with this aspect. You may speak a lot about your ideas and your feelings, but you are not a narcissist who refuses to help. You might be gifted with a speaking or singing voice that lets you reach out and captivate audiences at a deep feeling level. You could use your voice and your manner to successfully hypnotize subjects for medical procedures. This aspect increases your creativity and gives you meticulous attention to detail. It is a good aspect for a writer. Your approach to life is to try to live out your dreams. This is an aspect of entrepreneurs and wealth, but you could have a fluid relationship with money, with investments sometimes going bad. You will publicly advocate on behalf of causes in which you believe.

# Mercury square Uranus (Strength: 2.05)

28 men in the famous collection have this square aspect within one degree as compared to just 11 men with the trine aspect, an aspect disparity not seen in large control files. The square aspect challenges you to accomplish and to get attention. You are likely to have grown up in a large family. With your contentious personality, you could find work enforcing the law. You are not diplomatic and could yourself become a crime victim at some point. Personally disciplined and steadfast, this aspect is found among men who are mathematicians, ministers, comedians, fighters, politicians, architects, public speakers, radio or television personalities, pioneers, and slender. Your vice could be a love of alcohol, which might be connected to this aspect's high rate of divorce. Actor Burt Reynolds, who had this aspect exact, was a popular star for his nonchalant toughness, but high-spending ways and a calamitous marriage accelerated his slide into bankruptcy. Statistically, this aspect in general does a poor job of holding onto money.

# Saturn trine Pluto (Strength: 1.98)

It might surprise you to learn that the most frequently occurring categories for this combination of planets is comedian/humorous personality and alcohol abuser, which statistics are true for the charts of both men and women. It is like the alternating comedy and tragedy masks of theatre. Humor can be a mask that covers pain. This aspect is also associated with dementia and murder. When you see the world through the stark lens of these two planets, it is like the opposite of seeing through rose-colored glasses. You tend to be a competitive, driven, and enterprising fellow. You are good at erecting a structure for your life. You can handle complexity and precision. You are inventive and adapt well to opportunities in the moment. You like variety and you tend to be witty. You could have talent as an artist. Your style would be vibrant and spare. You can see what will likely have the biggest impact. You probably love to collect things. Your standards tend to be both high and expensive. You can be an agent of the law or you can become a victim of crime.

# Jupiter sesquiquadrate Chiron (Strength: 1.95)

This aspect expands your inner creativity and helps you to be successful. Stephen Foster, the composer of over 200 beloved and popular American songs in the 19th century, had this aspect exact to the minute. Your career could evolve from a hobby, from doing what you love. You can innovate a lucrative new field. Partnerships with people more experienced in business seem to work well for you. Frequent characteristics of this aspect include honesty, love of animals, diplomatic, spiritual experiences, intelligent, adventurous, and creative. Frequent occupations include mathematician, engineer, music composer, award-winning actor, and comedian. Least likely - law enforcement officer. Danger from alcohol, excess, and overweight. If you have a lot of creative ideas, it would be a good idea to record them all in a journal. This aspect favors a long marriage and a long life.

#### Mercury semi-square Saturn (Strength: 1.86)

This can be an aspect of the pioneer, the imaginative visionary who pursues huge dreams. You are probably good at using the computer to do research. The aspect seems to help with structured thinking. Claude Shannon, "the father of information theory," had this aspect exact. Growing up in a large family may have taught you to make your voice heard, which can help you as a public speaker, award-winning actor, diplomat, coach, broadcaster, singer, politician, lawyer, and teacher. Your imagination and creativity are high. You can become an enthusiastic marketer. A lack of stick-to-itiveness or continuity is shown, however, by rarely working at the same job after ten years as well as a high rate of suicide. You tend to learn from experience and correct your mistakes. You have the capacity for self-criticism. A champion chess player subordinated his own desires in order to perceive and deal with objective facts in a structured way. If you go to law school, you could become a successful prosecutor. You could be attracted to political organizing. You could have a wry, self-deprecating wit. If business is your first priority, at some point, the universe may forcefully convince you to reorder your priorities. You can be a responsible community leader, one who successfully mixes charity and business.

#### Uranus opposite Chiron (Strength: 1.78)

This generational aspect is found in a lot of charts from 1950 to 1990, so in order to manifest it needs to be exact or close to a chart angle. It will recur in 2097. The aspect motivates you to excel. Many singers, champion athletes, award-winning actors, chefs, radio/television announcers, coaches, musicians, and comedians were born with it. The aspect opens the mind up to questioning. The native knows or discovers that there is more to life than meets the eye. This aspect causes your mind to crackle with alternate possibilities. You live on the frontier of the new and different. You look for answers in books. When you were young, things happened that did not make sense. You could feel like a misfit. You might seem hyper-active. You will do things to shock people whom you perceive to be mentally rigid. Becoming a parent will probably cause you to question and shift your priorities. You will become more relaxed and focused if you study metaphysics, keep a journal, or practice yoga, meditation, or martial arts.

### Pluto inconjunct Midheaven (Strength: 1.74)

You have the ability to concentrate all of your energies. As a professional fighter, you could have explosive power and speed. Many men with this aspect work as law enforcement agents. This Pluto aspect can make you an influential reformer and pioneer, a mover and a shaker. You can master a professional or scientific subject and see where improvements need to be made. Your professional career will benefit from the intense focus that you give to it, but meanwhile your personal life can be in turmoil. There is a danger of alcoholic binges. Something about this aspect makes both male and female natives susceptible to cancer - it might be this aspect's long life expectancy. Men with this aspect tend to be technical and focused on enforcing their will, but the price for that focus is a high rate of suicide. Try to be kinder both to yourself and to others. With your focus upon worldly, career matters, you would do well to find a domestic partner who will successfully manage your family and household. You could have more ability

working with mechanical systems than you do with people. All the law enforcement agents, coaches, and doctors with this aspect have found a way to relate to people while still working with systems.

#### Neptune sesquiquadrate Ascendant (Strength: 1.68)

This aspect connects you to your human heritage. You could come from a large family with an advantaged background. In turn, you can help others to connect to their human heritage, possibly via your creative work. You can make people think. Many critics, public speakers, artists, vegetarians, writers, scientists, explorers, and researchers were born with this aspect. Enthusiasm, creativity, intelligence, and honesty drive your work. Unsettling experiences involving death, sexuality, or nervous breakdown, in particular, can occur in your life, experiences which have the effect of expanding awareness of the human condition. A mystic experience could profoundly affect you. Not being afraid of death, you are more likely to commit suicide or become a martyr. You could have a tendency to gain weight. Men with this aspect tend to make good husbands and fathers. You can be sensitive to discrimination and you can campaign for equal rights and equal treatment. You can be a voice for freedom and against oppression. You can attack authority and you can rock the boat. If you are put in charge, your perfectionism can be taken the wrong way. Art, music, dance, and poetry can appeal and be therapeutic.

#### Neptune sextile BlackMoon (Strength: 1.65)

This positive aspect from Neptune is found in the charts of successful men more so than from any other planet, including Jupiter. You are a colorful character who throws himself wholeheartedly into life. Your lack of inhibitions helps you to give it your all and stand out from the crowd. Many dancers have this aspect. Plus, your mental antennae are always soaking up new information, so that you tend to be on the futuristic cutting edge. Science and technology attract your interest. You can help guide and shape how they are used. You can also be a social and political activist who tries to shape the direction of society. You can be an advocate for anything that speeds up chores and communication. A man with this aspect declared, "Everything that makes for speed contributes to happiness and is a distinct gain to civilization." As a poet or writer, you know how to appeal to the emotions of your audience. When you commit yourself to doing something, you do it well. This aspect strongly correlates with men who are disciplined, perfectionists, honest, enthusiastic, and creative. If you have kids, then being there for them is important to you. However, marriage and family are statistically much more important for women who have this aspect. Others find you to be a likable and sympathetic man. You could succeed as a diplomat or chef.

### Mars conjunct North Node (Strength: 1.62)

This aspect puts you at the service of the people. You can be a marketer, computer expert, designer, researcher, medical professional, writer, scientist, pioneer, entrepreneur, or public speaker. You can be attracted to playing music or composing music. Hank Williams had this

aspect exact within 16 minutes. You might have fixed ideas about how to do things and not like people telling you what to do. You are not really cut out for an unexciting desk job or academic life. With your steadfast nature, you are more likely to join the military. You can do well in a sport like soccer or in a business where success depends upon you making your own decisions. You process input very quickly. You learn to take chances. Success comes to you when you learn to trust your hunches. You have an intuitive connection to what the common man thinks and feels. With this aspect, it is mandatory for you to have regular checkups for masculine problems such as heart disease and prostate cancer. External expression does not come as easily to the North Node as it does to the South Node. Find constructive ways in which to get impulses out of your system through action.

### Saturn semi-square Ascendant (Strength: 1.39)

With this aspect, carrying on a family tradition could be an important part of your life. You could be the focus or agent of family hopes. As a child, you could have been the eldest or an only child who interacted mainly with adults. You could already have a career at an early age. You have broad shoulders and can assume responsibilities that are greater than just your own personal interests. The statistics show that four or more kids are frequent and that divorce is rare. This aspect is likely to love animals. Spiritual experiences are more frequent. You can be adventurous. Many diplomats, law enforcement agents, and professional pilots and drivers have this aspect. This aspect gives you the precise control to be good at singing, speaking, drawing and numbers.

### North Node sesquiquadrate BlackMoon (Strength: 1.35)

This aspect makes you an investigator and a popularizer. You have an aggressive curiosity that inspires you to master any field to which you turn your attention. You tend to live in the mind, but you also become involved with your community and will do what you can to inspire young people in particular. If you are not too distracted by the body, you might have clairvoyant visions.

### Pluto sextile East Point (Strength: 1.33)

This is an aspect of intelligence. This aspect makes it statistically likely that you experienced some trauma during your childhood. You are also likely to have abused alcohol or drugs. You like challenging yourself with untraditional activities that are physically tough. You can pursue a regime of physical fitness. Many dancers, pilots, and doctors have this aspect. You stoically overcome your fears, possibly through psychoanalysis. The aspect is connected to supportive healing of others as well as to scary things like suicide and murder. It can seem as if many events in your life occur through fate.

# Sun sextile Moon (Strength: 1.32)

Men with this aspect are more likely to be born into a large family and to experience some family trauma. They tend to be forceful, enthusiastic, undisciplined, and intelligent. You are more likely to excel at marketing and public speaking. You are more likely to father several children. The actor and comedian Bill Cosby has this aspect exact within 10 minutes. Many psychologists, mathematicians, fighters, architects, pilots, law enforcement agents, astrologers, award-winning actors, directors, diplomats, music composers, and politicians are born with this aspect. The experimental psychologist Georges Thinès had this aspect exact within 1 minute. You are more likely to keep working at the same job. While this aspect is much less likely to abuse alcohol, you are more likely to experience divorce, depression, poverty, and suicide. The influential beatnik and writer Neal Cassady, who had this aspect exact within 3 minutes, had intelligence, an undisciplined sexuality, and a love of discussion.

# North Node sextile Chiron (Strength: 1.18)

You have the potential for inner growth. Things may happen in your life to push you further in that direction. You could have an inner vision to which you try to remain true, while at the same time you try to achieve acceptance in the world. You are probably dedicated to a healthier and more peaceful world. If you end up in a creative field in which you have complete control, you will be active and prolific.

# **Balance of Elements and Modalities**

### **Abundant Water**

In your case, the heart rules the head. Your emotional drives are strong and you act primarily on the basis of your feelings. Whether your feelings are purely personal, interpersonal, or transpersonal is up to you, but generally you are a life-oriented person who feels keenly and who acts to support your family, friends, and community. A lack of planets in Fire signs can be offset by a Fire sign ascendant or by abundant planets in the houses of Life.

## **Abundant Endings**

With abundant planets in the houses of endings, you are probably sensitive, moody, and introspective. You are not afraid to show your feelings and make an empathetic listener to the problems and feelings of others. You have been around the track enough yourself to sense what others are going through and to show that you care. You are not the most intellectual or practical person. You can be easily swayed by an appeal to your emotions.

## Lack of Substance

You are not the most grounded or practical person. The rules of this material world are not well known to you. Others may admire your dreams, but they could be impossible dreams. You may find it difficult to choose, plan, and work towards a career or vocation.

A lack of planets in the houses of Substance can be offset by abundant planets in Earth signs.
