

Introduction

This report from Halloran Software, In The Beginning, draws upon 1441 paragraphs which interpret the places of the planets at the time of your birth, describing your personal houses, sign placements, and planetary aspects.

These astrological delineations depict your potential and how to make the most of it, or the challenges you will continue to face and how to confront and benefit from them. Though you may change through experience, your inherent characteristics will still motivate how you act and react to circumstances. How you handle yourself is really a clue to your success, and it is up to you to make the "right" choices.

Here are the parts which make up your chart:

HOUSES: Govern sections of your life, e.g., your money, your health, your partners, etc. They are also meaningful as to where your early interests lie and if they are worth pursuing.

SIGNS: Contribute feelings or vibrations to "colour" planets, e.g., MERCURY rules GEMINI and VIRGO and emphasises their qualities of thought, travel, health, and work. JUPITER rules SAGITTARIUS and higher education, spiritual growth, and law.

ASPECTS: Are angles combining the planets in the SIGNS/HOUSES that trigger the manner in which you will be influenced or can handle your qualities to advantage, e.g., MERCURY (thought) TRINE (in good aspect to) JUPITER (education and law) may indicate that you can succeed as a counsellor in legal matters.

A "Strength" number precedes each ASPECT interpretation towards the end of the reading. This number synthesises how exact is the aspect, whether the aspect is major or minor, and whether an aspecting planet is close to one of the four chart angles. The higher the Strength, the more you are likely to feel the aspect and to live it out in your life.

You are most likely to feel and act out the report's sign and house placement interpretations when the planets involved are strong in your chart. This is true especially of the outer planets, Jupiter through Pluto. AstrolDeluxe has a Planet Strengths graph that calculates the respective power and harmony of all the planets in your chart.

Planets in Signs and Houses



Capricorn Ascendant

(The Constrained)

You seem, and may look, older than you are. You tend to hold your head high so it appears you are looking "down your nose" at the world. Your features are usually slender, and somewhat sharp. You have a clear, concise way of speaking with authority that causes others to pay attention. You are a student with a purpose, excellent study habits and are self-disciplined. Because you work hard and expect to succeed, you have a good chance of doing so on your terms.



Sun in Taurus

(Keynote: I OWN)

You have deep material and spiritual concerns and are patient, kind, romantic and firm in your resolves. You are also capable of being stubborn, unyielding, self-indulgent, possessive and jealous. You enjoy tangibles that have weight and intrinsic worth, and display your assets and achievements prominently. Your aesthetic hunger makes you a patron of the arts. You will forgive, but not forget an injustice. A need for security can override your integrity, but you will defend your means to achieve an end because you cannot accept yourself if others find you wanting.

Sun in the Second House

(The Aspirant)

Your focus is on your ability to earn and learn. It is not that you value money above all else, but resources will always be important to you and represent your basic security. You may set standards early and be on the lookout for ways to improve your station. Your idea of success is to set a goal, achieve it, and then set a new goal a little higher than the first. Who can blame you if you take pride in showing what you have accomplished through your hard work? Many a philanthropist has received satisfaction by donating his treasures for public display, that others may enjoy them.



Moon in Leo

(The Prominent)

Everything is a "big deal" in your life. You expand both the negatives and positives and express yourself dramatically. You are a "head-turner," like the attention you attract, are generous with your money and enjoy being thought of as a "big-time spender." Your organisational ability, coupled with your self-confidence and popularity, often places you ahead of your competition in business, though you must watch a tendency to become "bossy." If you are too self-indulgent, you should call upon your natural honesty and recognise it as a fault which may be difficult to overcome.

Moon in the Seventh House

(The Searcher)

You may never feel complete after you leave the mother-influence until you find a life-partner who fits OR is the opposite of her image. This will depend on the positive or negative programming you received in childhood. If you select a partner in business, you will choose someone as shrewd as yourself. You may enter any partnership when you are nudged by gutfeelings too intense to be denied, or dissolved when conflicts are too dangerous to be ignored.

Mercury in Aries

(The Quick Study)

You "catch on" fast, but are apt to drop ideas as swiftly as you conceive them. Your assertive attitude may put off those who feel threatened by your ability to take charge. You usually go with first impressions and will only change your mind reluctantly, if proven wrong. Your famous temper may flare on occasion, but quarrels are quickly forgotten. You are self-serving, express confidently, and only need to modify your actions to achieve the rewards you desire.

Mercury in the Second House

(The Juggler)

You can do more than one job, but find it difficult to establish a life-direction. Choose a goal and realistically determine the time it will take to accomplish it. Resolve to finish what you start. Otherwise, you may become a "Jack of All Trades and a Master of None." That would be a great pity because you have valid avenues open to you. Most would lead you to a productive existence of great personal satisfaction culminating in S-U-C-C-E-S-S!

Venus in Pisces

(The Compassionate)

You often realise the needs of others before they ask your help and are on hand to volunteer your time, money and services for those less fortunate than yourself. Emotions overrule your practicality in most cases and sentimental compassion may override personal relationships. If you are "unlucky" in love, perhaps you should not sacrifice it on the altar of public charity, but also acknowledge the needs of those who care for you and deserve consideration.

Venus in the First House

(The Charmer)

You'll learn early how to utilise your good looks, sunny disposition and outgoing personality to attract friends and have little trouble getting your own way. Partners will always be important to you, so you should learn to share willingly. Use as your spiritual guide the lesson of St. Francis: "...It is by giving that one receives." Perfect your gift of beauty on your personal universe. There is no better way to use it.

Mars in Aquarius

(The Forerunner)

You focus on the future and see things with amazing clarity, so are apt to be impatient with those who do not have your vision. Your motives are the best -- to do for others what they cannot do for themselves. You are a matchless fund-raiser and know who to approach and what to say to accomplish your missions. You extend this nurturing quality in your personal life. All who recognise your kindness are sure to return the interest and appreciation you deserve.

Mars in the First House

(The General)

You'll be aware from the time you're born of the tremendous power you hold. No task is too great for your dynamic energy to challenge. However, before congratulating yourself, you must recognise you are impulsive, and sometimes lack the patience to finish what you start. Your enormous ego drive will demand you assume responsibility for the actions in your life. Slow down long enough to ask: "How will my choices affect others? Is the result worth the effort?"

Jupiter in Aquarius

(The Cosmopolitan)

You are truly liberal in your humanitarian views. What some call "idealistic," you practice as a way of life. You sympathise with minority needs and work with the majority to improve mankind. Visionary gifts allow you a glimpse of the future. If you succeed in your efforts to enrich the world, it will be a far better place in which to live.

Jupiter in the First House

(The Bon Vivant)

You love life and life loves you right back! People enjoy your company, and you have plenty of it. Your confidence inspires confidence and your very presence is a lift to the spirits. If you exaggerate truth, it's only because you are expansive by nature and if something is good, you want to make it better -- and, you usually do!

Saturn in Scorpio

(The Forceful)

The powerful image you create tempts you to thrust your ideas or will upon others, not always to their benefit -- or YOURS -- but just for a show of strength. Your determination can make enemies and undermine your fine executive abilities. Try to develop the compassion and flexibility inherent in all successful leaders. Otherwise, your effectiveness will be limited. You will be a champion without honour and must look to yourself for any rewards you receive.

Saturn in the Ninth House

(The Thinker)

You probably have the self-confidence usually born of long experience, no matter your age. Your powers of concentration enable you to absorb the essentials of life in great chunks. A career in law may satisfy your sense of justice. However, inherent knowledge may preclude the experience to utilise it. If your viewpoint seems narrow, look for ways to augment it. Like the Bluebird, you may find them waiting in your own back yard.

Uranus in Pisces

(The Medium)

You are an ultra-sensitive who is drawn to the mysteries and will begin to encounter the unusual early in life. You must overcome fears of your unique gifts and extend them through competent teachers and studies of the occult. You may choose to enrol in religions or philosophies that advocate "new thought." You will not always be right, but can subdue feelings of despair. Your real mission is to find ways to use your talents and knowledge to benefit others.

Uranus in the Second House

(The Opportunist)

You are quick to react to sudden windfalls or calamities. Challenges cause you to re-examine your priorities. You are aware that "destiny" plays a hand in your affairs as the result of the course you have set, and that personal evolvement demands change. You are not afraid to adopt an unconventional means of self-discovery or explore the unknown. You may choose a career in science or investigate astrology as a hobby--then make it your profession!

Neptune in Leo

(The Actor)

You are "glamour-struck" by the charisma of the theatre. You may choose a career in drama, fashion, design or in some way make the world more beautiful. Your life may suffer from a romantic ideal of what love is. Expectations of marriage should be aired by both parties before entering a formal contract, and adjustments honoured. A "common-law" arrangement will not substitute for a desire to "--live happily ever after", nor satisfy your powerful instincts as a parent.

Neptune in the Seventh House

(The Idolater)

You find it difficult to define the "whys" and "wherefores" of relationships and may question why you have come together. It is usually "something" inside that tells you a partner is your soul-mate -- that you were fated to be together, and are on the same spiritual level, which may or may not be true. You may go into business with or marry your best friend, which is not a bad idea. It is important that you know someone well before making a commitment.

Pluto in Cancer

(The Resentful)

Your family life is in constant flux. Some of it seems without purpose and can cause you to feel a loss of the love you cherish. Strong feelings may indicate that you are in some personal way responsible for the estrangement you sense, whether it is evident to others or not. It is important to find someone older to talk to, particularly in your formative years, who may placate your fears and start you on the road to self-reliance, which is the answer to your problems.

Pluto in the Sixth House

(The Alarmist)

By developing a practical fitness regime early, you may allay your fears that your health will undermine your plans for the future. Resist impulses to follow fads that promise much and deliver little. Also, avoid the tension of seeing yourself at your job in the extreme, as either threatened or indispensable. Otherwise, you may work unnecessarily hard to prevent losing what you have gained. Moderation in all things should insure you a long and productive life.

Scorpio Midheaven

You will do well in a career which involves your ability to feel out and involve others in a collaborative venture. You are emotionally intuitive, both about potential partners and about the direction of society as a whole, so that you can speak what people are feeling. You yourself may have gone through deep transformations connected to traumatic events. You are comfortable reaching down into the depths of any subject and so make a good researcher or investigator. You are happiest in an occupation which allows you to explore and produce constructive results. Your strength may involve you in a power struggle with authorities until you can achieve a compromise. Your commitment is such that you make a dangerous enemy. Some people with this placement are so inflexible that they stay with a job that they hate.

Power and control will be issues in your life. You have the ability to co-ordinate the efforts of others in teamwork, handling power tactfully and with concern for the rights of others. Work with others for transformation and improvement, as opposed to maintenance of the status quo, and you will enjoy great success. Selfishness, ruthlessness, and overkill are the negative possibilities of this placement. Try to spread both the effort and the benefits to others.

Occupations consistent with your intense style of work include investigator, researcher, critic, engineer, programmer, mechanic, contractor, wrecker, exterminator, dramatic writer or poet, sex therapist, tailor, musician, entrepreneur, government or large company worker, surgeon, chemist, pharmacist, detective, psychologist, mortician, insurance actuary, artist, or the military. For the most personal career guide, also consider the nature of any planets which fall in the 10th house or conjoin the Midheaven, the sign and house placements of Pluto, ruler of the Midheaven, and any aspects which other planets make to the Midheaven.

North Node in Cancer

(The Regressor)

Your biggest stumbling block is your pride. If you don't receive the respect you feel you deserve, you will distance the love you desire. Learn to give without expectation of rewards and remember the selfless nurturing received in childhood. Offer that same care to others who need it now, if you would receive full value for emotional investments.

North Node in the Sixth House

(The Healer)

You must overcome your fear of the unknown before your restorative powers become evident. At times, your own physical ailments and surprising recoveries will call attention to your gifts

until you are confident to explore and refine them. Acknowledgement of your own self-worth is repayment for the years granted to serve your fellow man.

Chiron in Aries

Chiron is a minor planet that orbits in between Saturn and Uranus. In the astrology chart, Chiron serves as a bridge between normal consciousness and higher consciousness. Chiron can bring limitations, but it is also connected with finding ways to overcome limitations, to heal and to grow. Chiron spends an average of four years in any one sign, so everyone born in the same years will have the same sign placement. Chiron's sign placement is most likely to influence your life if Chiron has many aspects or is near one of the four angles in your chart.

You may start life unsure of who you are, wondering about your identity, but you can be anything that you want to be. You have a low-key but competitive personality that will carry you far. You recognise that, while you have to be natural, you also have to be different. The result is that you have a distinct and precise style. You have a trick of getting the maximum of attention with a minimum of fuss. You are a hard worker, but you follow your own path and tend not to observe old-fashioned rules. If your initial career efforts do not pay off, you will adapt and try something else. A strong Chiron with favourable aspects makes it likely that you will be athletic and competitive. With inharmonious aspects, you could be a reformer. You could identify a career in your teen years, only to be blocked from immediately pursuing it. A health-related matter could boost your career. More than most people, you learn the possible ways that you can be from the different mentors and partners whom you attract. You, in turn, are willing to help mentor and teach others.

Chiron in the Second House

Something about your person or body could be distinctive. You may have been frail or have needed corrective surgery when young. Your physical endurance and energy is excellent. You could be a photographic model or be involved with cosmetics or other products for the body. You could create furniture, be a plastic surgeon, or be a sculptor. You might just frequently change your style and hair colour. Gratification, of a physical, sexual, or financial nature, is an important part of your life, but in a consciousness-expanding way. You could have a career that somehow involves the reproductive system. You could also excel at managing resources and creating infrastructure.

Planets in Aspect

Saturn square BlackMoon (Strength: 6.85)

This aspect is very strong for Elizabeth II, the Queen of England. As a child she was polite, responsible and well-mannered around adults. During WWII, she worked as an ambulance driver and mechanic. She has presided over independence for forty former territories of the British Empire, while responsibly fulfilling her duties as monarch. As a young woman, Elizabeth had the same kind of wholesome good looks as Janet Gaynor, an actress with this aspect, known for playing virtuous and plucky characters. This aspect makes your politics progressive, not reactionary. Rosa Parks with this aspect almost single-handedly started the modern civil rights movement. Sally Ride became America's first female astronaut in space. The aspect gives good powers of concentration and logic. You are always coming up with what you think are innovative and better ways of doing things. You could put a science and technology education to good use. You can perform incredible feats in your head. You tend to be private, exposing little of your personal thoughts and feelings. You are not the type to wear a lot of makeup or jewellery.

Ascendant conjunct South Node (Strength: 6.20)

Many women with this conjunction were born to be national leaders or are in pioneering positions of popular leadership. If you have this aspect, you feel an obligation to serve as a role model and/or play a responsible leadership role. You feel an obligation to the collective self to use your talents in service to society. You love your community. You could work to end blights such as poverty, crime, and ignorance. You could have a talent for starting, founding, or leading organisations and societies. The South Node person acts more in association with others while the North Node person acts more as an individual.

Neptune contraparallel East Point (Strength: 6.18)

This aspect can give you good earning power. Money can come to you in unexpected ways. Perhaps you went through a family trauma that forced you to become more independent. You may have felt oppressed by your parents or by society and needed to chart your own rebellious course. With this aspect, you could be inclined to break laws or social conventions. Many women with this aspect end up having several children. The early trials and training that you go through have the effect of developing your strength and awareness. This aspect gives you insight into human nature and the human condition. Medicine is a popular field. When you search for knowledge, the world opens up to you. You could go into business as an entrepreneur and use your experience to mentor others. You can network with important people. There is an increased likelihood of dementia and loneliness with age. The vocations that are found most

frequently with this aspect include doctor, nurse, or veterinarian, singer, artist, businesswoman, dancer, politician, actress, athlete, teacher, writer, and astrologer.

Jupiter parallel East Point (Strength: 6.05)

This aspect makes you someone who embraces life as it is and who takes what enjoyment she can. You probably have a fresh, natural beauty. You could have a high opinion of yourself. Others can treat you with deference, though not always. You can insist upon proper behaviour and manners. You can convince powerful people to support you. You are willing to work hard within the system. You could have a love for nature. You can feel deeply the kinship between nature and the soul of humankind. You can be an excellent businesswoman. Other vocations found with this aspect include musician and pilot. The aspect gives a long life-expectancy.

Jupiter opposite Neptune (Strength: 6.05)

You tend to be mentally disciplined as well as creative. When you were young you could have been flashy and spunky like a tomboy. You could achieve wealth through marriage or career. You could develop your own voice and style, whose expression you will put above crass economics. Women with this aspect often have four or more children. You have an independent spirit, which can be difficult on your relationships. Many writers have this aspect.

Jupiter contraparallel Neptune (Strength: 5.52)

With this aspect, the spiritual mind challenges the everyday mind. Fearlessness is combined with enthusiasm. Mentally you are active and wide-ranging. You probably have an excellent memory. As a teacher, your style could be humorous and vivid, using examples to enliven your subject. You can have a public life in which you are popular with people and groups. You can be an advocate for an interest group. What can make you successful as a leader is your ability to recognise talent and then delegate responsibility. You are good at building friendships. You maintain your relationships through your ability to compromise. This aspect is rarely found among businesswomen. You try to deal with people fairly. You lack the ruthlessness for cuthroat competition. Popular vocations with this aspect include chef, marketing, politician, medical professional, writer, poet, teacher, artist, comedienne, and pioneer.

Midheaven square BlackMoon (Strength: 4.99)

With this aspect you could have a talent for organisation and business. You have a love of freedom and openness which could help you work with artistic types, nurturing their creativity. In your personal life you could be very impulsive, quickly jumping in and out of relationships or even marriages. An actress with this aspect was known for creating a chaos of discord on the set.

Freedom of speech is important to you. You would not like being censored. You can be known for your razor-sharp wit and unabashed outspokenness. There is a danger of feeling sorry for yourself. You can fix that by taking complete responsibility for how you are. You could play a role in the larger public world, sharing what you have learned. You love animals and can work to have them treated with dignity. You can defend the underdog.

Saturn conjunct Midheaven (Strength: 4.92)

(The Award)

It may take you some time to get where you're going, but your hard work and perseverance will pay off. Lay your plans carefully. Achievement of your goals has nothing to do with "luck." Do not alienate yourself from those who care for you and are willing to follow your lead. You need their support. You tend to be inflexible, but be prepared to restructure your thinking. As a realist, you should allow enough margin for error to absorb the revisions that assure your success.

Mars opposite Neptune (Strength: 4.82)

You are a strong and steadfast or stubborn person, but you are not one who goes out to enforce her will or the viewpoint of authority onto others. You tend to immerse yourself in the happenings of the day. You can be modern or ahead of your time. This aspect gives you creativity and enthusiasm. You can function as a popular channel, succeeding in careers such as social activist, poet, dancer, athlete, therapist, writer, or singer. You cannot be wholly a channel for others, however, or you run the risk of depression because you are not owning or expressing your own true feelings. You could like how alcohol dissolves your anxieties. This is an aspect of health and beauty. Many women with this aspect enjoy long marriages and give birth to four or more children. The aspect could expose you to spiritual experiences. You could work to heal or to rescue others. There is a good chance that you will become a vegetarian.

Sun conjunct Chiron (Strength: 4.81)

You welcome challenges as opportunities to grow. You approach difficulties enthusiastically and can become a real pioneer. You grow to where you are able to successfully juggle complex responsibilities. Excellence in others does not daunt or intimidate you. You have an ability to creatively combine the dream with reality. You may feel that you are here to realise a great purpose, and will lose interest when the challenge has been successfully met.

Neptune opposite East Point (Strength: 4.78)

This aspect corresponds to wealth and long relationships or marriages. It makes it more likely that you will have four or more children. You could be an enthusiastic cook. This aspect is often found in the charts of nurses, writers, comediennes, singers, dancers, teachers, poets, activists, and businesswomen. You are easily bored and can be looking for outlets for your creativity. You may need to get past a traumatic family event. You could be looking for a man who is a protective father figure. A high frequency of suicide can be attributed to this aspect's roller-coaster emotions. You tend to be a perfectionist. You could have spiritual experiences and be psychic. You probably have a love for animals.

Venus trine Pluto (Strength: 4.75)

This aspect strongly correlates with working within organised medicine to help others. It gives you social insights and opinions that you readily express. You can be a talker, a writer, or a poet. You could travel and become acquainted with different cultures. You are a good listener. If the aspect enables you to pick up information psychically, it is because you are coming from love. There is such a thing as being too open, however, as this aspect also correlates with crime victim. You probably love the bustle and vitality of city life. Something about this aspect gives you inventiveness and ingenuity. You have ability for therapy, astrology, and art. You can inspire people. This aspect correlates with a long life.

Moon sesquiquadrate Uranus (Strength: 4.53)

Your mind is constantly active. One or more painful experiences in your childhood may drive you forward. You could seem like a shy oddball. You gradually emerge from your shell. An athletic sport could be an outlet for you as a young woman. The aspect gives you the mental focus to improve through practice. You could briefly try living a normal or conventional life only to realise that it does not satisfy you. In some ways you have a defiant, nonconformist attitude. You could be attracted to technology, writing, aeroplanes, or anything that lets you rise above normal limitations. You can be enthusiastic about scientific or medical research. The aspect opens your mind to different points of view. You seem to be versatile, adaptable, and prolific. The aspect corresponds to wealth, a long marriage, several children, and a long life. You can inspire many people. You could decide to enter politics. You like a man to treat you as an equal, and not treat you with kid gloves. You don't particularly want a man who gets close in a needy or clingy way. You could even be attracted to a man who is not completely available.

Moon contraparallel Midheaven (Strength: 4.42)

You could do a good job with both motherhood and a career. You have energy, versatility, and organisational abilities. This aspect gives you a connection to the public. You are interested in other people. You understand what appeals to people. You can be a perceptive judge of character. You could feel like you are part of a big family, with whom you are generous. In your

career you could have considerable stamina and staying power. With this aspect you could often travel or move to a different address.

Ascendant contraparallel North Node (Strength: 4.39)

You could have an extended family with whom you do things. You can be in touch with your ancestry. You could work in the same field as your parents or siblings. You tend, however, to be a pretty modern type of person. You may have had an unsettled childhood and started work early. You tend to stay trim and good looking. You tend to be an easy-going extrovert. This aspect can make you a pretty independent citizen of the world. You tend to be comfortable working with a group or team. You can be the one who delivers the pep talks. You could start your own school or society. What attracts you romantically to a man could be that he feels like family. When you see people in need, you will do what you can in order to help. Your mind can be open to eccentric or unorthodox views. You could have a talent for confrontation and getting results. Vocations that are frequently found with this aspect include businesswoman, pilot, scientist, engineer, the military, healer, psychologist, athlete, musician, lawyer, and writer.

Mars conjunct Jupiter (Strength: 4.34)

(The Exuberant)

You are interested in expanding your capabilities, perhaps through extended learning or travel. Though impulsive, your successes can result in a belief that you lead a "charmed life," and there is little you are afraid to tackle. You enjoy leading others in the fulfilment of your goals. Since your desires and seemingly-unlimited energy are unified, there is virtually nothing you cannot accomplish, once you have the resolve to complete what you begin.

Uranus trine Midheaven (Strength: 4.19)

What is most interesting about this aspect is the low statistical frequency of the following categories: disciplined, creative, perfectionist, and enthusiasm. The lack of these helpful qualities may explain why alcohol, depression, and criminal behaviour are a problem for a high number of women who have this aspect. The favourable trine is notorious for being the aspect of ease. You could find that poetry and art come easily to you. Work is required for a successful marriage. With this aspect, you can be too quick to start a relationship, which can make divorce frequent. This aspect gives ability and can even give wealth, but you need other aspects in the horoscope to give you discipline and motivation. Some women with this aspect are pushed into a career by their fathers. The positive energies of Uranus are for astrology, computer technology, business, comedy, design, music, and medicine. The category that is least frequent with this aspect is female scientist. You may not feel motivated to raise a large family. However, more than most, this aspect gives you free will.

Jupiter square Saturn (Strength: 4.05)

(The Wary)

You are much like the old song that complains: "You have a feeling that you wanna go -- then, you wanna stay -- but you gotta go!" You have an urge to expand or break away from restrictions, but may be overly careful -- as if you never feel you have what it takes to succeed, so are a perpetual student instead of a graduate in the school of life. You may set modest goals, unworthy of your higher potential. Faith in yourself will prepare you for the success you can achieve.

Jupiter opposite BlackMoon (Strength: 3.97)

This aspect heightens your femininity and emotional qualities. You can be both vulnerable and strong. As a wife and mother, you are committed and know what you are doing. You bring high quality to your work, your family, and your life. Your life should be long and active.

Neptune inconjunct Ascendant (Strength: 3.68)

This aspect gives you intelligence and the ability to see outside normal boundaries. You are not looking to fit in with normal society. You are more attracted to the powerful underside of life. You might cause trouble through insubordination, but your good looks allow you to get away with a lot. Balance of Elements and Modalities

Abundant Water

Abundant Life

Abundant planets in the houses of life gives you both the energy and the urge to create the future. By your activities, you make the world a better place. You may be somewhat self-centred, but with your crusading spirit you move the world towards the ideals that you envision.

Lack of Endings

You live on the surface of things, afraid to look within at what you really feel and want. Perhaps your position is too precarious or the obligations too great to allow yourself this luxury. You feel forced to maintain your personal status quo. You come across to others as unfeeling. Because personal feelings do not distract you, you might make a good scientist, though be aware that the greatest scientists let intuitive feelings be their guide.

Abundant Fixed

With an abundance of planets in Fixed signs, you have the staying power to complete a project, grow a family, or expand a business. Your strength is what friends notice most about you. You have definite values; you focus your affections on the people and things that are part of your team. Friendships formed over time are important to you. You may be found at the centre of a circle of friends, a large family, a government agency, or a business. You understand the contribution that stability and security make to prosperity and growth. It throws you off-balance when friends are not as reliable as you are or when love and ideals are not part of your life. Concentrate on developing confidence in yourself, a wholesome world for your family or group, and binding others to you with love. If you have a weakness, it is trouble changing or listening when people tell you a better way to do things.
