Introduction

This report from Halloran Software, In The Beginning, draws upon 1354 paragraphs which interpret the places of the planets at the time of your birth, describing your personal houses, sign placements, and planetary aspects.

These astrological delineations depict your potential and how to make the most of it, or the challenges you will continue to face and how to confront and benefit from them. Though you may change through experience, your inherent characteristics will still motivate how you act and react to circumstances. How you handle yourself is really a clue to your success, and it is up to you to make the "right" choices.

Here are the parts which make up your chart:

HOUSES: Govern sections of your life, e.g., your money, your health, your partners, etc. They are also meaningful as to where your early interests lie and if they are worth pursuing.

SIGNS: Contribute feelings or vibrations to "color" planets, e.g., MERCURY rules GEMINI and VIRGO and emphasizes their qualities of thought, travel, health, and work. JUPITER rules SAGITTARIUS and higher education, spiritual growth, and law.

ASPECTS: Are angles combining the planets in the SIGNS/HOUSES that trigger the manner in which you will be influenced or can handle your qualities to advantage, e.g., MERCURY (thought) TRINE (in good aspect to) JUPITER (education and law) may indicate that you can succeed as a counselor in legal matters.

A "Strength" number precedes each ASPECT interpretation towards the end of the reading. This number synthesizes how exact is the aspect, whether the aspect is major or minor, and whether an aspecting planet is close to one of the four chart angles. The higher the Strength, the more you are likely to feel the aspect and to live it out in your life.

You are most likely to feel and act out the report's sign and house placement interpretations when the planets involved are strong in your chart. This is true especially of the outer planets, Jupiter through Pluto. AstrolDeluxe has a Planet Strengths graph that calculates the respective power and harmony of all the planets in your chart.

Planets in Signs and Houses



Sagittarius Ascendant

(The Forthright)

Your most outstanding quality is your cheerfulness, even in the face of adversity. Your friendly grin is always ready, open, and happily infectious. You think and speak rapidly. It's hard to stay angry with you, since your charm outweighs your lack of diplomacy, but the bluntness of your words can be detrimental to your success. Try to practice patience, tact and discretion, as in the axiom: "If you can't say anything worthwhile or pleasant, don't say it at all!"



Sun in Cancer

(Keynote: I FEEL)

You are sensitive, nurturing, devoted and caring, but can be moody, petulant, over-emotional and unforgiving. Your attachment to the home stems from an allegiance to a mother-figure. Your interest in food may extend to gourmet cooking as a hobby or a career. You are an excellent business person, with a shrewd and logical view, but tend to keep things to yourself, which is not always wise. If you have no outlet for your feelings, you may make yourself the victim of digestive ills, or prolonged seclusion may cost you the friendship of those who represent security in your life.

Sun in the Seventh House

(The Partner)

Partnerships will always take precedence in your life because of the power you give them. You feel the need of another person to keep you in balance. It is vital that you learn how to compromise your views to agree with those of other people. Though you may be the primary agent in a relationship, at some time you may have to take a subordinate position. If you are not prepared to do this, your pairing will suffer and may turn into an open conflict. Partnership requires team effort. Do your best to find solutions to problems that will benefit you both.



Moon in Aquarius

(The Individual)

You are not always practical, but are unorthodox and misunderstood by those who do not appreciate that you are a true liberal of rare talent. You cannot be restricted by the bonds of convention or a regulated society. Whatever you do is done with all your heart, but once you have accomplished your purpose, you move on, which may give you a reputation of indifference. Your independence can result in loneliness, though you surround yourself with people and join causes in which you strongly believe. You search for enlightenment to bring you to the state of peace and tranquility you long for.

Moon in the Second House

(The Collector)

You may take some time to settle into a job. Bank a portion of your paycheck -- even ask someone to manage your money for you. Otherwise you may become a compulsive spender, gathering possessions which may substitute for emotional needs. Going it alone, you may identify too closely with your possessions. In choosing a partner, it should be a person who is appreciative of your spiritual, as well as material growth and is willing to contribute and grow with you.

Mercury in Cancer

(The Parent)

Your remarkable intuition lets you see the vulnerability of your fellow man, but it may be somewhat narrow in concept. You often depend more upon feelings than rationale to treat issues in an appropriate manner. You may tend to relive childhood experiences, which can make you moody and sometimes reclusive, if the recall is painful. Rather than retreat, learn from experience and consider the consequences of present actions as they may affect your future.

Mercury in the Seventh House

(The Acrobat)

You are definitely not a loner. Your on-going love affair with words calls for the companionship of a partner to share your mental gymnastics. Your friends will be innovative and clever, but your indecisiveness and an inclination to avoid serious commitment may prevent you from a conventional marriage. Use your famous intuition to select an appropriate life-mate, while your carefree attitude is still admired as "charming," rather than "childish."

Venus in Virgo

(The Unappreciated)

Your feelings are vulnerable to the slights of others. Perhaps in retaliation, you have a tendency to overanalyze and criticize any partners in your life. You may also invite those whose standards are not your own, thereby giving you an opportunity for such censure. Use the discretion you employ in business to choose someone who will appreciate your fine qualities of selectivity and is able to expose the sympathetic nature you bury beneath the cool exterior you present.

Venus in the Eighth House

(The Heirs)

In any partnership, look for shared values and beliefs on which to form a foundation. In business, careers may depend on joint finances. In personal relationships, allow your qualities of a lively imagination and curiously-experimental mind room for expansion. Together, you may build a worthwhile estate, or inherit the career of another to manage. Two heads are better than one because you will encourage personal growth from the combined centers of your beings.

Mars in Sagittarius

(The Skeptic)

Your demeanor is one of extreme self-confidence and defined direction. You are distrustful of established regimen, prefer to march to your own drummer and defy others to keep up with you. Red tape is "there to be cut," but you realize you must operate within certain confines to make your innovative ideas acceptable. You are a person who "packs his own chute." If you must fall to earth, it will be on your terms and you have no one to blame but yourself.

Mars in the First House

(The General)

You'll be aware from the time you're born of the tremendous power you hold. No task is too great for your dynamic energy to challenge. However, before congratulating yourself, you must recognize you are impulsive, and sometimes lack the patience to finish what you start. Your enormous ego drive will demand you assume responsibility for the actions in your life. Slow down long enough to ask: "How will my choices affect others? Is the result worth the effort?"

Jupiter in Cancer

(The Weight-watcher)

You may attract and absorb too much of a good thing, if you are a gourmet cook, or take the world's burdens on your sympathetic shoulders. Your acumen in business is unquestioned, but without someone to share your triumphs, you become disconsolate. What you do for others is done from love; a day without friends is indeed a day without sunshine.

Jupiter in the Seventh House

(The Alliance)

Whether your partnership is professional or personal, your mate must allow you room to expand. Your original intent may be that you can accomplish more as a team than as individuals. This works best if you agree to share quality, rather than quantity time together. Otherwise, your need for independence will soon split an otherwise productive pairing.

Saturn in Scorpio

(The Forceful)

The powerful image you create tempts you to thrust your ideas or will upon others, not always to their benefit -- or YOURS -- but just for a show of strength. Your determination can make enemies and undermine your fine executive abilities. Try to develop the compassion and flexibility inherent in all successful leaders. Otherwise, your effectiveness will be limited. You will be a champion without honor and must look to yourself for any rewards you receive.

Saturn in the Tenth House

(The Deliberator)

You know what you want. You make your plans carefully, and you are willing to study, work hard and do whatever it takes to achieve your goals. On your way to the top, be careful not to ignore or alienate those close to you. Once you reach your zenith, try to find ways to reward your supporters. Otherwise, you are liable to find yourself successful but solitary, with a void in your life that can only be filled by those who care for you.

Uranus in Cancer

(The Whimsical)

You are an uncommon, often-disruptive influence in the home. Overly-sensitive, you can brood over imagined wrongs, but may never voice your unhappiness or resentments. Others may not comprehend your dour moods. You can benefit by quiet times of self-analysis. Try to include your loved ones in discussions that will strengthen your bonds and prevent the dissension associated with your eccentricities. Much may be accomplished by mutual understanding.

Uranus in the Seventh House

(The Dancer)

You attract unusual partners. Like a child at a masquerade ball, you frolic through relationships, sometimes ignoring commitments. Circumstances in which you enter your associations will be in constant flux, requiring you to cope and mature. You may feel helpless to do so. Then, rely on past experiences to guide you. Apply success patterns to present circumstances, or, if you have been unsuccessful in the past, try to correct your actions.

Neptune in Libra

(The Influenced)

You are subject to peer pressure which may not always serve your best interests. Because you are an idealist, you may be drawn into causes that are without substance. You seldom attempt anything alone, and prefer groups to a partner. If your dreams don't interfere with the reality of a material world, you can inspire others to adopt altruistic ways of living. It is your belief that what we have is not as important as our willingness to share it.

Neptune in the Tenth House

(The Bewildered)

As if establishing goals for career and initiating a life course were not difficult enough, before you complete your education, you may despair of fitting into ANY role you have chosen. Rather than change WHAT you are doing, try to discover if you are realistic about your potential and the manner in which you apply yourself. If you need the advice of a counselor, choose one who does not deal with abstractions, but can suggest a practical means of achieving success.

Pluto in Leo

(The Agitated)

Your ability to keep things at a fever pitch needs careful regulating to avoid constant upheaval in your life and the lives of others. Your senses are keen. Use them to recognize a need for transforming human affairs. Take your place in bettering your environment by helping others to better theirs. It is preferable to accept the accolades of your peers for your good work than to indulge the self-aggrandizement negatively associated with your sign.

Pluto in the Eighth House

(The Rejuvenator)

Your life is one of constant change, as though you are living several lifetimes in one. Your gifts of intuition and an ability to restore to advantage when things fall apart are in your favor. You can usually see beneath the surface of any situation, which gives you a decided edge, but try to avoid circumstances which put someone else in the driver's seat. You can look forward to each transforming experience which usually announces a period of spiritual growth.

Libra Midheaven

You will do best in a career which makes use of your social skills and which allows you to appeal to popular tastes. You have an in-born sense of beauty and proportion which could lead to a career in the arts. Friendliness and social poise are important to you, so that you would make a good diplomat or agent. A partner may play an important role in your career.

Not impulsive, you strive towards a fair assessment of every situation. You can help others to see the many different choices available, in such fields as communications, publishing, advertising, teaching, politics, or therapy. With your love of variety and social interaction, you have a wide picture, but not a deep picture. If you are not successful in your career, it will be because you use your charm to avoid work, or are too indecisive, superficial, or pleasure-loving. Have confidence in your own judgment and do not become overly dependent on other people.

Occupations consistent with your aesthetic style of work include public relations, architect, artist, musician, diplomat, designer, theatrical agent, builder, planner, strategist, arbitrator, or social commentator. For the most personal career guide, also consider the nature of any planets which fall in the 10th house or conjoin the Midheaven, the sign and house placements of Venus, ruler of the Midheaven, and any aspects which other planets make to the Midheaven.

North Node in Capricorn

(The Infant)

You may be a "mama's baby," and enjoy the role, but must give up childhood pampering, or continue tossing on a sea of emotional turmoil. When you assume adult responsibilities, you will exercise your fine qualities of honor, loyalty and discipline. Then you will earn the respect and pride, as well as the love of parents and peers, which you have always known.

North Node in the First House

(The Individual)

You accomplish most when you "do it yourself," but this does not mean you are capable of miracles. First, you must know who you are and what you want; then how to make your plans work for you. You may be tempted to lean on others, but that will only weaken your ability. Refine your skills and learn to enjoy challenges, because your success-ratio is high.

Chiron in Capricorn

Chiron is a minor planet that orbits in between Saturn and Uranus. In the astrology chart, Chiron serves as a bridge between normal consciousness and higher consciousness. Chiron can bring limitations, but it is also connected with finding ways to overcome limitations, to heal and to grow. Chiron spends an average of four years in any one sign, so everyone born in the same years will have the same sign placement. Chiron's sign placement is most likely to influence your life if Chiron has many aspects or is near one of the four angles in your chart.

This Chiron placement puts a lot of pressure on you to become an adult while you are still a child. You feel strongly the limits that circumscribe your life. The final goal of your efforts is to get to a state of greater freedom. A strong Chiron in Capricorn makes you defensive, tough, and controlled. These qualities stand you in good stead in the world of business. You also know human nature and are not naive. Chiron here gives you a sense of connectedness with the rest of society, so that you could end up becoming a compassionate philanthropist, one who wants to make the world a better place, in which no one is left out or left behind. You do not limit yourself to the small world of the home -- you are aware of and you get involved with the larger public world.

Chiron in the First House

You are quite a character, definitely following your own light. You stand out from the crowd as someone who is always pushing the envelope forward. As a minor planet between Saturn and Uranus, Chiron in the first house gives you some of the qualities of both planets: the discipline of Saturn and the iconoclastic inventiveness of Uranus. You have high personal standards that make you a tireless worker - detail-oriented and very thorough in your preparation. You have an open mind and are willing to consider alternative philosophies and disciplines such as meditation. You have a deep awareness and understanding of how systems work. There may have been times in your life when you had to deal with serious illness, prejudice, or other limitations.

Planets in Aspect

Uranus square Neptune (Strength: 9.37)

This is a generational aspect that will mainly affect you if it is close or if it contacts the Sun, Moon, or one of your four chart angles. It occurred from 1865 to 1872 and again from 1952 to 1957. It will occur again from 2037 to 2043. The aspect indicates that as an individual you tend to be ambitious and respected, but that within your family there can be friction and stress. You tend to be mentally curious and can educate yourself. This aspect increases your ability with technical equipment, including musical instruments. It gives you the discipline to do well in school, where this aspect is often found in the charts of doctors, lawyers, politicians, astrologers, businesswomen, writers, broadcasters, and scientists. Many women with this aspect have managed to combine career with family, raising several children. You have a love for animals and nature. Astrology, mysticism, and spirituality could appeal to you.

Sun square Neptune (Strength: 7.63)

You could be born into a large family, but have strikingly original observations. Many female pioneers, inventors, and scientists were born with this aspect. It increases your initiative to have a strong Sun aspect. You tend to be creative and a perfectionist. You could have talent for music and singing, but also for design and mathematics. You can popularize a subject. The image that you display to the world could be different from your well-guarded private self. Indulging in alcohol can make you a risk taker. Personal questions make you uncomfortable. This aspect can make you a visionary. Through your work you can end up mentoring others.

Neptune sextile Pluto (Strength: 6.62)

This aspect heightens the higher mind and awareness. You are unlikely to lead a narrow or sheltered life. You have a broad viewpoint. You explore and ask questions.

Moon parallel Chiron (Strength: 6.55)

You could be born with a limitation that you must overcome. Chiron has to do with overcoming all kinds of limitations, which can include health problems, weakness, social prejudice, insecurity, and fears. There is a possibility that you will be overwhelmed and will slip into alcohol and dementia. However, this aspect endows you with compassion and hope. You could work on behalf of a charity for children or animals. You can work to heal sick people. Your energy level, your passion for life, and your performance tend to be at a high level. You can be very disciplined. The discipline required in the fields of science and law should come easily to

you. Chiron orbits in between Saturn and Uranus, so Chiron has something of the natures of both of those planets.

Neptune conjunct Midheaven (Strength: 5.88)

You have the ability to be conventionally successful, but you see that there is a deeper side to life, which can make you a 'seeker'. This is an aspect of intelligence that is found in the charts of many artists, psychologists, scientists, lawyers, activists, medical doctors, nurses, or therapists, pioneers, and astrologers. You can successfully translate theoretical knowledge and learning into a worldly career. You tend to have a high level of willpower and enthusiasm. Watch out for dementia, however, especially if the Sun or Mercury has few aspects in the chart. You could adopt a child. You have a lot of love to give. This is one of the top aspects for a woman to have four or more children.

Sun conjunct Uranus (Strength: 5.86)

(The Precarious)

You are constantly trying to express as an individual, sometimes before you are entitled to an opinion. Others may regard you as "disruptive" rather than "unique," and a "rebel" rather than an "innovator." But, some admire your liveliness, which serves to keep your life and the lives of others from the ruts of boredom. Like Ben Franklin, you must harness the electricity you generate without allowing it to destroy you in the process.

Sun opposite Chiron (Strength: 5.64)

Experiences in your life have marked you as kind of a tough guy. The result is that you can have close to a fortress mentality, in which you look out for yourself and are determined that no one is going to put anything over on you. This aspect increases your practical intelligence -- you will probably enjoy some success in life, but you will hide that you need the success in order to alleviate inner pain that is left over from childhood. You are able to turn adversity into something constructive. You are quite comfortable being the center of attention -- you will find and perform activities which ensure that you stay there. You can be a fierce and capable competitor. Look for alleviating supportive aspects in your horoscope, especially to the Sun and Chiron -- the activities indicated by those aspects are the ones that will actually bring you peace. You can also turn your powerful mind towards searching for life's deeper meanings. Setbacks or illness might be the impetus for doing that.

Pluto contraparallel Ascendant (Strength: 5.23)

This can be a challenging aspect. You could be born with advantages, but have a cold or domineering father. Women who have this aspect close can deal with so many challenges that they attempt to take their own life. You could have a love for healing. both of people and of animals. You have the ability to focus outside of yourself on others, to take a genuine interest in them. You tend to be an independent woman and an original thinker. You experiment and observe what works. When it comes to your career, you can try out several possibilities. You can be a pioneer, one who is ahead of her time. You are good at creatively innovating in the moment. You tend to have a high-intensity style. You will not be a clingy wife and you will not get along with a dominating husband. As an equal partner, you can make a mature man happy. With this aspect you just might make a childhood dream come true. Mothers with this aspect often have four or more children. Vocations that frequently occur with this aspect include professional dancer, artist, therapist, psychologist, lawyer, actress, and athlete.

Saturn conjunct BlackMoon (Strength: 5.22)

This aspect helps you to see the world at a high level. It increases your capacity for control and precision. You can be a high achiever and perfectionist. Emotionally, you could be too self-critical. It will help your self-esteem if you can find constructive and creative channels for your intellect. You can be a technically capable equal partner. You can innovate new and successful formulas. If you pursue higher education, you could do well in science. You tend to be open-minded, low key, and unpretentious, someone who sees the humor in situations. You have a passion to learn and can teach yourself. You earn the respect and trust that comes with working hard and playing fair. You behave like a grown-up. You tend to be good at controlling systems, instruments, and machines.

Ascendant parallel North Node (Strength: 5.13)

You tend to be fashionable, stylish, and socially aware. You tend to be in the middle of what is happening. You can influence others. You can tell which way the social winds are blowing. You could know in advance where to make investments, where to buy property. You can hitch your wagon to a rising star. You could keep yourself fresh and well-informed by visiting different friends. You can be artistically creative. It is important for you to feel that you are working with a group or for an audience. You can popularize technical information. You could excel at advertising or promotion. You can be good at climbing the corporate ladder as a result of making correct social decisions and by charming people. You can be a social drinker. Vocations that are frequently found with this aspect include computer expert, artist/painter, astrologer, musician, the military, healer, and teacher.

Neptune square Chiron (Strength: 4.70)

This aspect increases your feeling nature. You can overreact to relationship problems. You are far from naive, however, showing great wisdom about life from an early age. That wisdom can lead you to tackle tough-minded fields such as medicine, business, or astrology. The aspect makes it more likely that you will have psychic and spiritual experiences. On the negative side, you are more likely to abuse drugs or alcohol and experience depression and divorce. This aspect increases the level of your creative imagination, which could make you highly prolific and versatile as a storyteller or artist. You put a lot of feeling into everything that you do. Many women with this aspect raise four or more children. In addition to creative work, you could be attracted to the pharmaceutical industry, winemaking, charitable work, teaching, and public service. A disproportionately large number of women with this aspect become lawyers, often in order to right wrongs. If you yourself ignore boundaries or rules, you could get into political or legal trouble. You can be very popular because you or your work make people feel good.

Jupiter conjunct South Node (Strength: 3.94)

You are good at taking advantage of opportunities that come your way. When you commit yourself to exploring something, you do so intensively, at least until a better opportunity comes along. With the conjunction to the South Node, as opposed to the North Node, you are more into expressing yourself than you are into protecting yourself. This helps you to become involved and part of a larger world. You are a versatile and hard worker who is able to add that extra something at just the right moment, which makes your work stand out from the crowd. People generally find you generous, good-natured, and friendly.

Uranus opposite Chiron (Strength: 3.51)

This generational aspect is found in a lot of charts, so in order to manifest it needs to be exact or close to a chart angle. It opens the mind up to questioning. The native knows or discovers that there is more to life than meets the eye. This aspect causes your mind to crackle with alternate possibilities. You live on the frontier of the new and different. You look for answers in books. When you were young, things happened that did not make sense. You could feel like a misfit. You might seem hyper-active. You will do things to shock people whom you perceive to be mentally rigid. Becoming a parent will probably cause you to question and shift your priorities. You will become more relaxed and focused if you study metaphysics, keep a journal, or practice yoga, meditation, or martial arts.

Mars trine Pluto (Strength: 3.24)

With this aspect, you are attracted to challenges. The nature of the challenge will depend upon your other aspects, such as Neptune-Mercury for ballet, Moon-Mercury for comedy, Jupiter-Midheaven and Venus prl Mars for beauty queen, Uranus-Midheaven for astrology, Mars 135 Neptune for psychic, Sun cpl Pluto for tennis, or Sun cpl Mars for track and field. This aspect

keeps you active and slender. You display grace under pressure. The aspect could give you a temper, for which it helps to have a constructive outlet. There is a risk that you will abuse alcohol. Many female activists have this aspect. The medical field could also present a worthy challenge. This aspect gives you the ability to reinvent yourself.

Mercury conjunct Jupiter (Strength: 3.07)

(The Attainer)

You view life on a large scale and are sure that you can always do more than is expected of you. Though you are understanding of others' views, you are not likely to be influenced by them and are confident within yourself. However, if you can expand your thinking through new ideas, you will do so. You are well-liked because your attitude is positive and you have the ability to say the right thing at the right time to lift the spirits of those who need it.

Mercury semi-square Pluto (Strength: 2.86)

With this aspect, you will put your all into whatever you tackle. Congenial occupations can include medicine and business. You are competitive, professional, and intense. Your purity and directness, especially when young, can take you far. The aspect is about change and transformation, however, so it is easy for you to suddenly drop one learning direction for another. This aspect increases the chances that you will battle depression. You are courageous and you can blaze new paths. You might find yourself attracted to a powerful man. It might not matter to you that he is married because you tend not to see limits or boundaries. The same tendency can cause problems with food or drug addiction, as you go directly to what gives you a high. What can turn you around are the young people who admire your strength and who need your help. When love flows through you, it gives you positive reasons to watch your health and to be your best. You can excel in multiple roles. You can bravely face the worst that life has to offer and arrive at life-affirming solutions.

Saturn semi-square Ascendant (Strength: 2.77)

With this aspect, carrying on a family tradition could be an important part of your life. You could be the focus or agent of family hopes. As a child, you could have been the eldest or an only child who interacted mainly with adults. You could already have a career at an early age. You have broad shoulders and can assume responsibilities that are greater than just your own personal interests. At some point, you may need to rest and recover from temporary depression or breakdown. Until people get to know you, they could mistake your shyness for aloofness. You could decide to postpone marriage in favor of your career. You could feel that your life is controlled by fate.

Venus sextile BlackMoon (Strength: 2.64)

You can be an artist or writer who is interested in empowering the average woman. You could be quick to learn and practice new, modern methods. You can be a perfectionist. Sometimes you must tone down the quality of your work in order to reach the common person. With your mastery of the details, you can make the big picture comprehensible. You could get involved with beautifying or improving your local community. You can be a gracious social networker. You could have a flair for drama, publicity, and promotion. You are likely to be highly creative. You can really be engaged in a quest for self-discovery when you are in the process of artistic creation. Such a personal quest finds the most truth when free of limits, with no concessions made to convention or morality. You have the gift of honesty and seeing through the bullshit. Much of your life may be devoted to feeling cut-off and isolated, with your work designed to bridge that gap and achieve belonging and connection with others.

Sun inconjunct Mars (Strength: 2.09)

(The Precocious)

The excitement on which you thrive may be the cause of your basic instability. You are frustrated by "lazy" or indifferent attitudes and can turn your volatility into inflammatory health problems. Your haste can produce accidents and injuries which may involve your partners. Discrimination should become your watchword. Consider the views of others. Rather than scatter your energies, wait for the proper moment to channel them towards your success.

Pluto sextile Midheaven (Strength: 1.89)

This is the aspect of a woman to whom the world responds. Many successful businesswomen and artists have this aspect. Whatever your field, through focus, dedication, hard work and good judgment, you can make systems work for you and become a leader. This aspect can add so much intensity to your life and experiences that it has temporarily driven some natives crazy. However, you are good at healing both yourself and others.
